2016-2017 REGULATORY PLAN

Below is the Department of Revenue's 2016-2017 Regulatory Plan, which has been prepared pursuant to the requirements of section 120.74(1), Florida Statutes.

1. PLAN REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 120.74(1)(a), FLORIDA STATUTES
