13	Clerk instrument number		Official Clerk Instrument Number *If the property appraiser uses the O.R. book and O.R. page number, leave this field blank.	Numeric Field Up to 20 Characters
14	Sale identification code		A unique code assigned to each itemized sales transaction. This code should be either a unique internally generated code not exceeding 25 alphanumeric characters or a four-digit code of which the first two digits indicate the year (14 or 15) and the second two digits indicate the transaction number (01, 02, 03, etc.). This identification code remains with the sale for all subsequent pertinent submissions. Preferably, the transaction part of the code reflects the chronological order of processing of the sale.
