## SALES AND USE TAX

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Sales and Use Tax collections were above the estimate in October by \$35.8m (1.9%) and over the 2013 October collections by \$165.7m (9.5%). The estimates are based on the August 7, 2014 Revenue Estimating Conference (REC) (page 3).

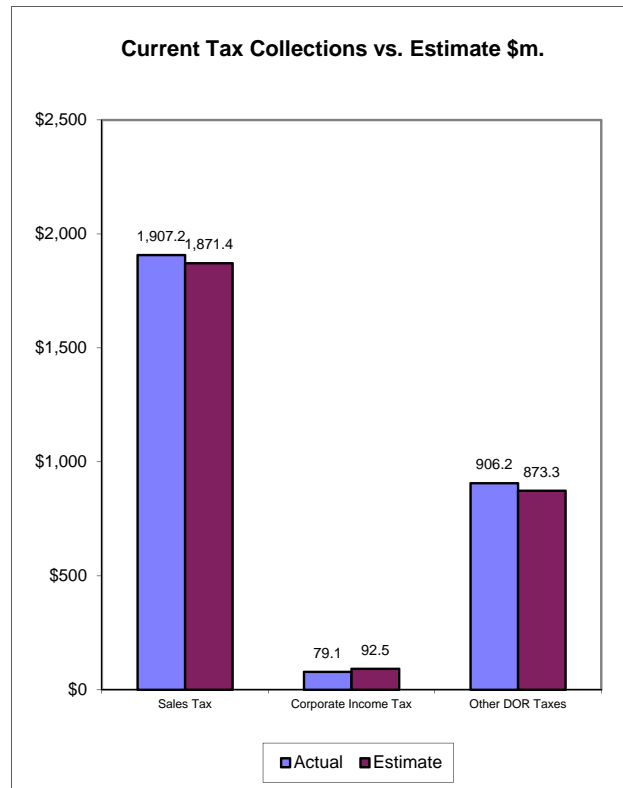
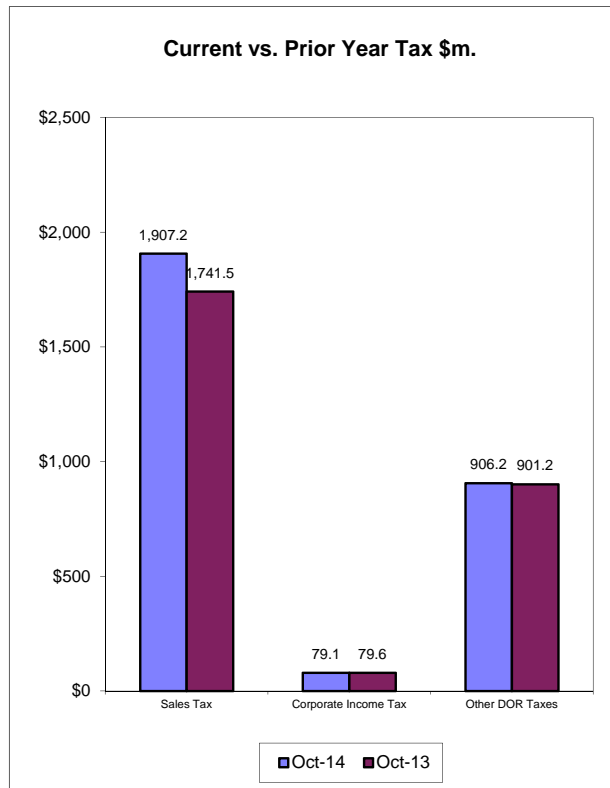
### CORPORATE INCOME TAX

CIT collections of \$79.1m in October were below the estimate by \$13.4m (14.5%) and below the 2013 October collections by \$0.5m (0.6%). The estimates are based on the August 7, 2014 REC conference (page 4).

### DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX

Documentary Stamp Tax collections were above the estimate by \$18.4m (12.1%) in October and above the 2013 October collections by \$20.2m (13.5%). The estimates are based on the August 7, 2014 REC conference (page 5).

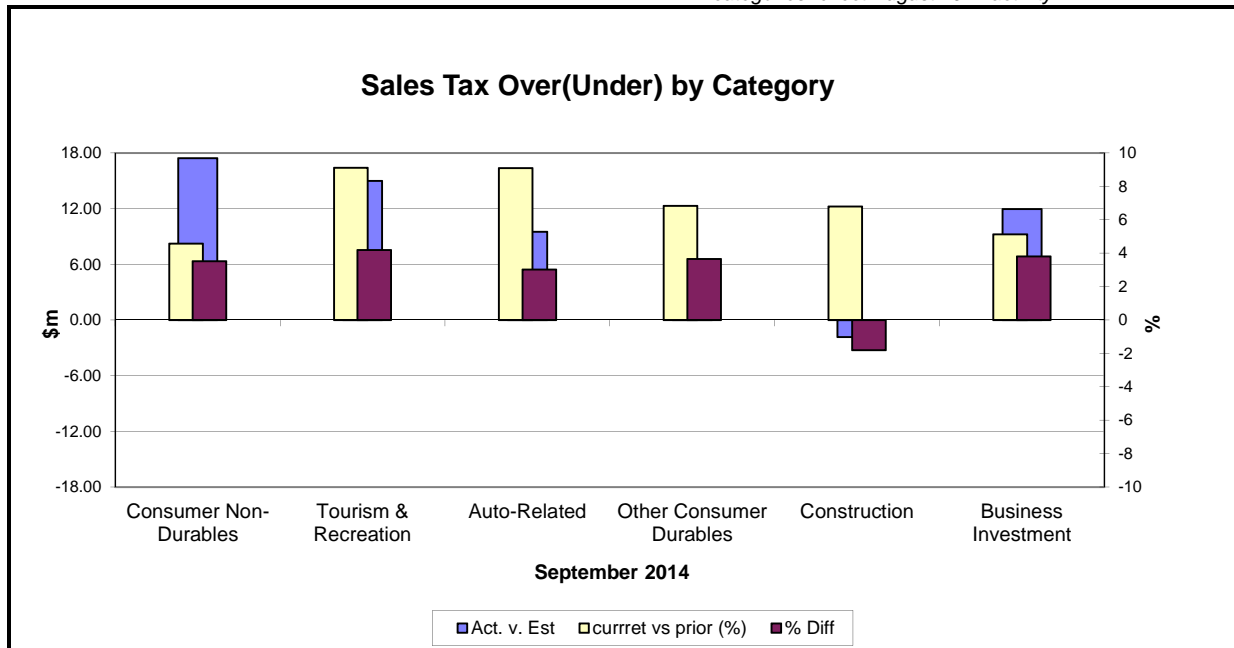
**SALES TAX ...**

... COLLECTIONS IN October 2014 of \$1,907.2m were \$35.8m (1.9%) above the estimates. The October Sales and Use Tax collections were \$165.7m (9.5%) above the October 2013 Sales and Use Tax collections (see Graph on page 1). The estimates are based on the August 7, 2014 REC conference.

**Analysis of September collections by category...**

Five categories were above the estimates in September, Tourism being the strongest (4.2%) followed by Business Investment (3.8%) and Other Consumer Durables (3.7%). The collections on Construction were below the estimates by \$1.8m (1.8%). Compared to September 2013, all six categories were above the same month collections last year, Auto-Related and Tourism being the strongest (9.1%) followed by Constructions (6.8%) and Other Consumer Durables (6.8%).

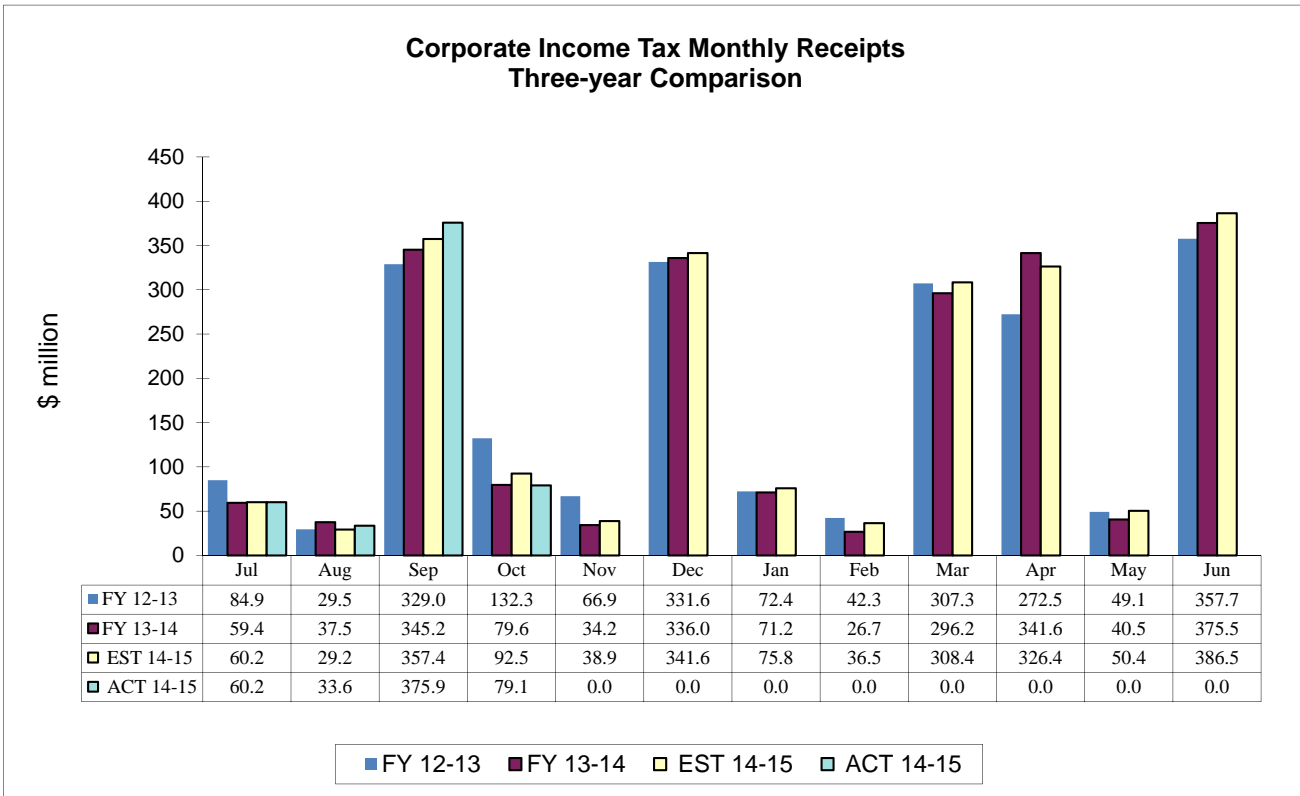
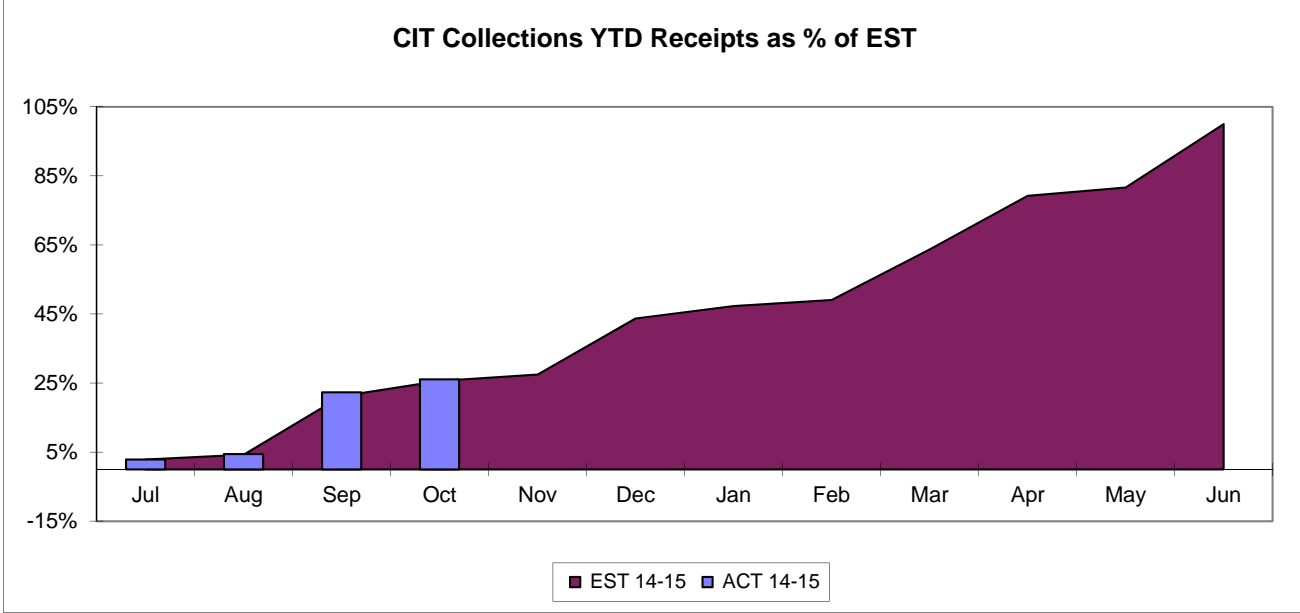

**CORPORATE INCOME TAX....**

.... Collections of \$79.1m were \$13.4m (14.5%) below the October estimates. The October 2014 CIT collections were \$0.5 million (0.6%) below the October 2013 CIT collections. The estimates are based on the August 7, 2014 REC conference.

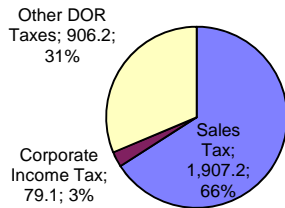


## OTHER DOR TAXES...

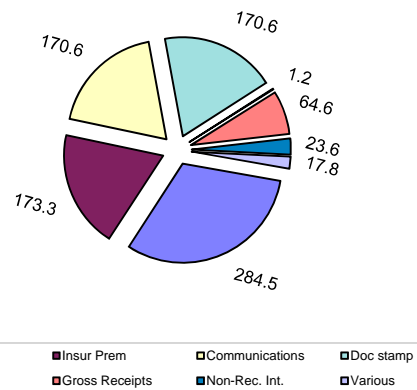
...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax contributed \$906.2m to DOR tax collections in October, which were \$32.9m (3.8%) above the estimates. The October collections were \$5.0m (0.6%) above the same month previous year's collections. Doc Stamps collections were \$18.4m (12.1%) above the estimates. The Doc Stamps collections in October were \$20.2m (13.5%) above the October 2013 collections. The non-recurring Intangible taxes in October were \$2.7m (12.7%) above the estimates. Compared to the October 2013's collections, the non-recurring Intangible taxes were 13.9% below.

The October collections on Fuel Related Taxes were \$6.1m (2.2%) above the estimates. Compared to October 2013 collections on Fuel Related Taxes, the October 2014 collections were \$12.8m (4.7%) above. The Communications Services Tax collections were \$0.9m (0.5%) below the estimates. The 2.5% Gross Receipt Utility Tax collections in October 2014 were \$6.5m (13.6%) above the estimates, and were 15.1% above the same month's collection in the prior year. Insurance Premium tax collections were \$0.8m (0.4%) below the estimates in October 2014.

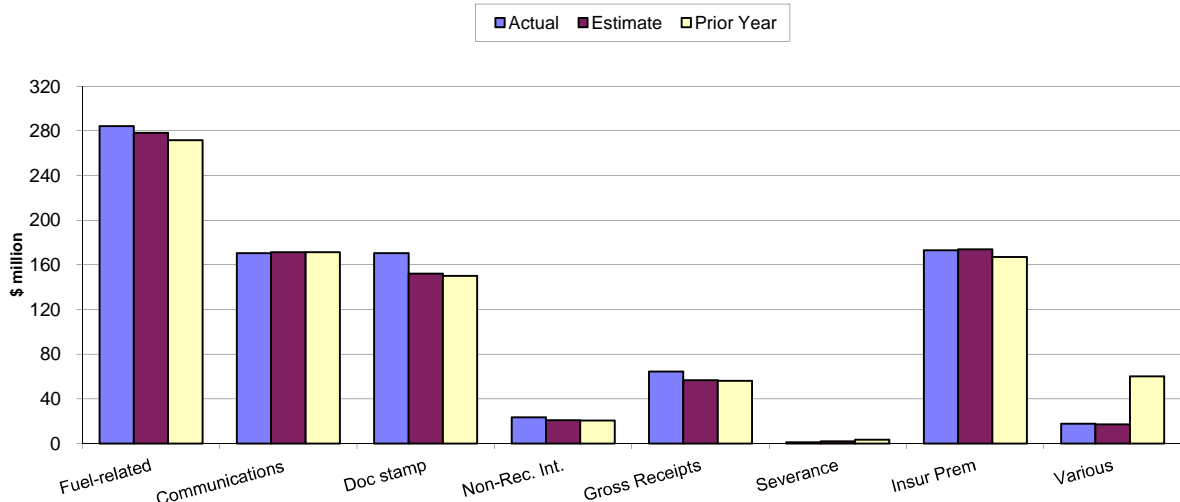
**Sales, Corporate & Other DOR Taxes \$m.

October 2014**



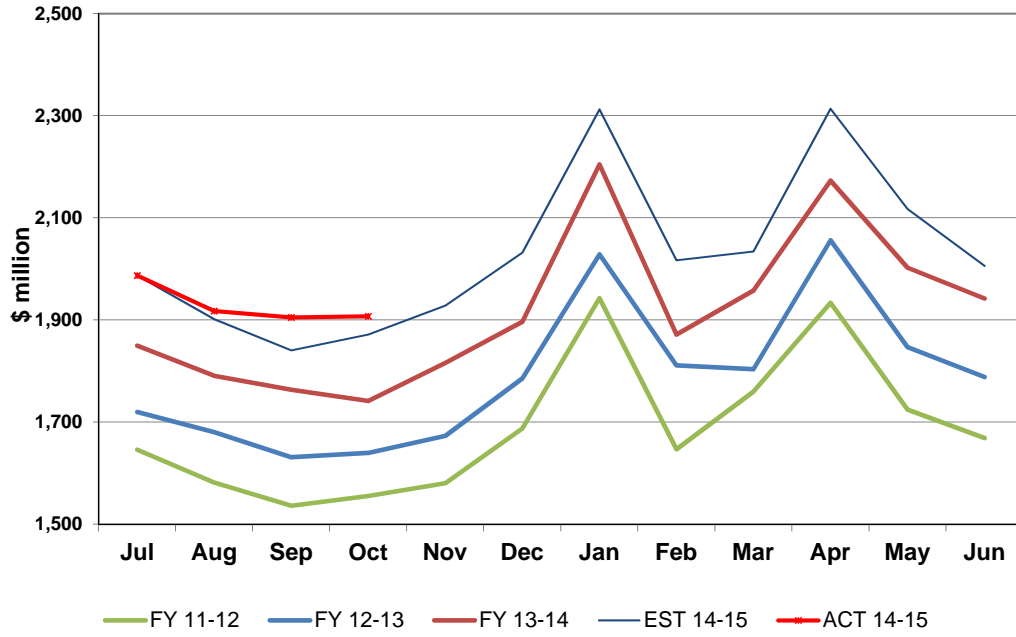

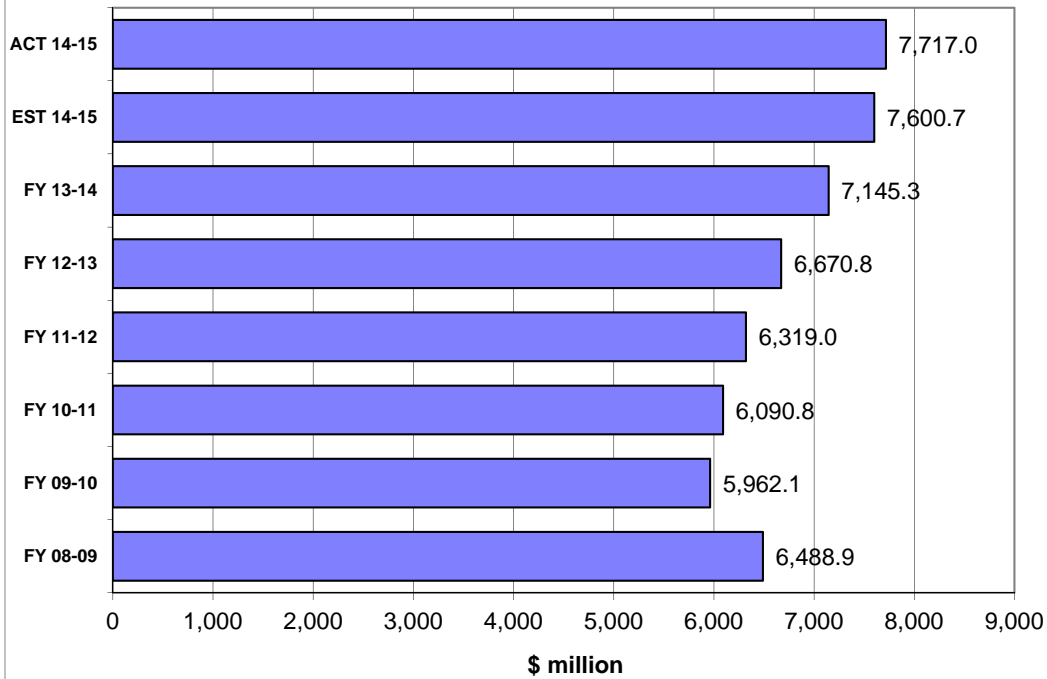
## HISTORICAL COMPARISON GRAPHS

*Pages 7-16 contain graphs for individual tax sources comparing the current fiscal year's actual and projected collections and collections for the three most recent fiscal years. The upper panel on each page presents monthly collections. The lower panel compares actual and expected collections on a fiscal year basis. In the lower panel, the bars prefaced by 'ACT' depict actual collections through the current month of each respective year. The bar prefaced by 'EST' shows that cumulation of the current year's DOR estimate through the current month. DOR's estimates are derived from estimates produced by the REC in **August 2014**. These estimates are adjusted to make them compatible with DOR's cash collection figures.*

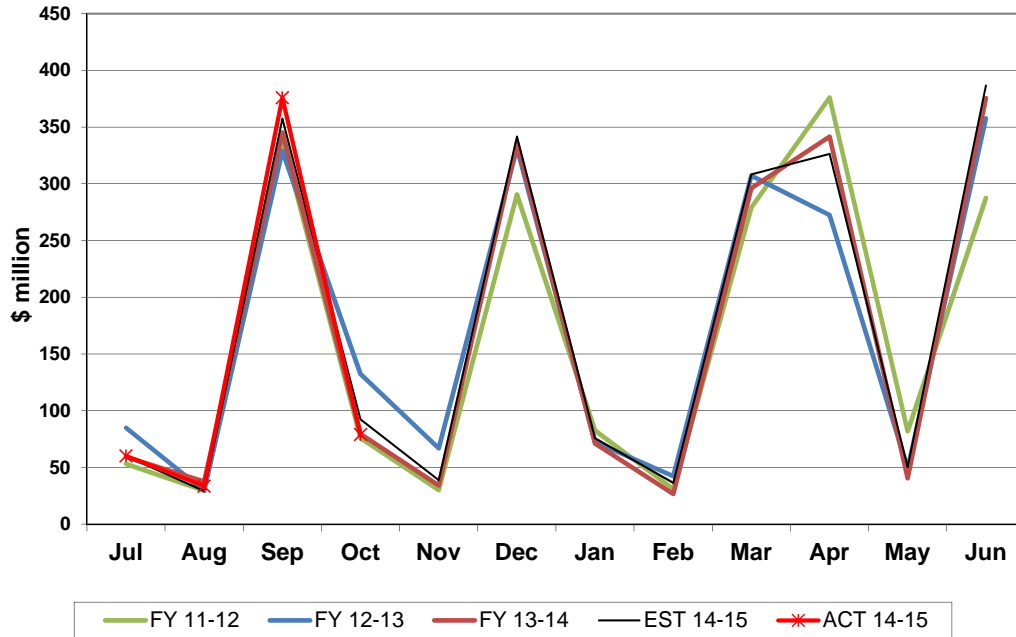
### Sales Tax Collections Monthly Receipts



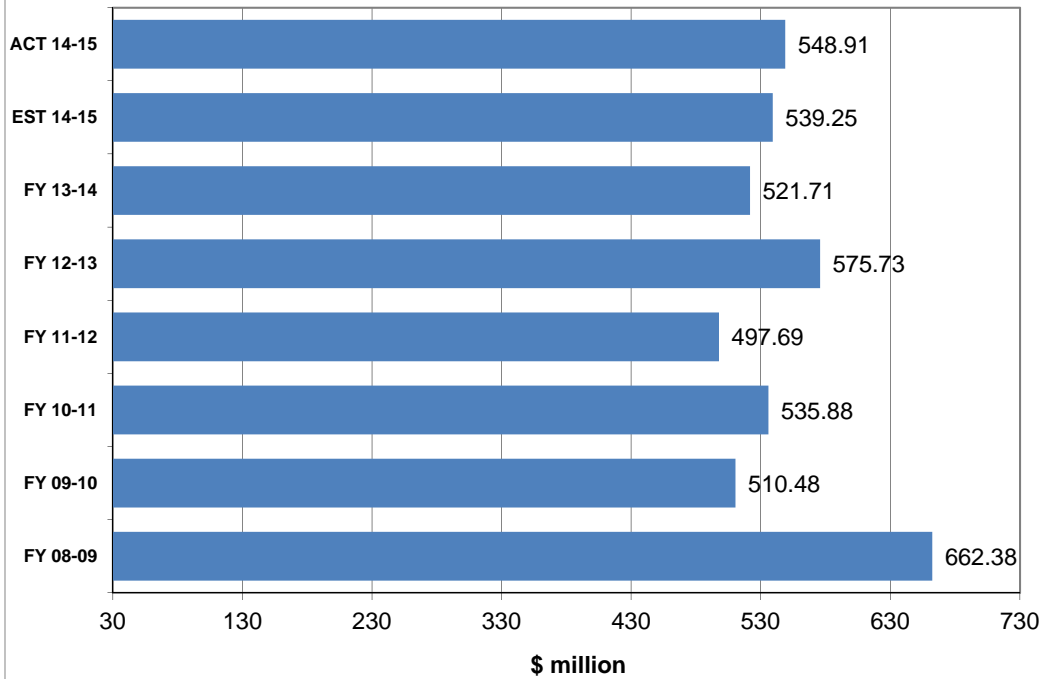
### Sales & Use Tax Receipts Fiscal Years through October



### Corporate Tax Collections Monthly Receipts

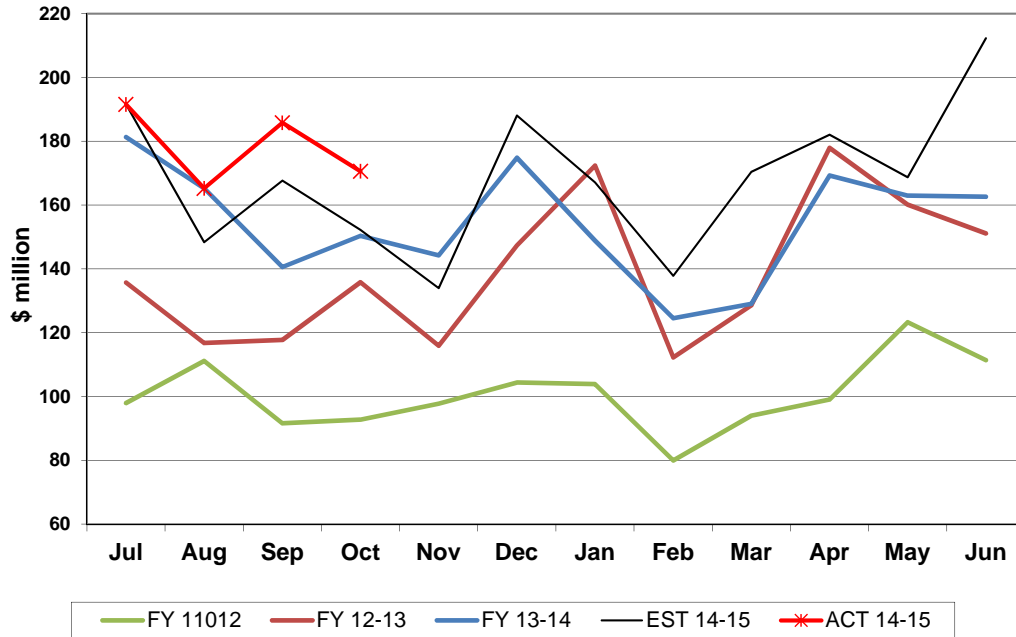


### Corporate Income Tax Receipts Fiscal Years through October

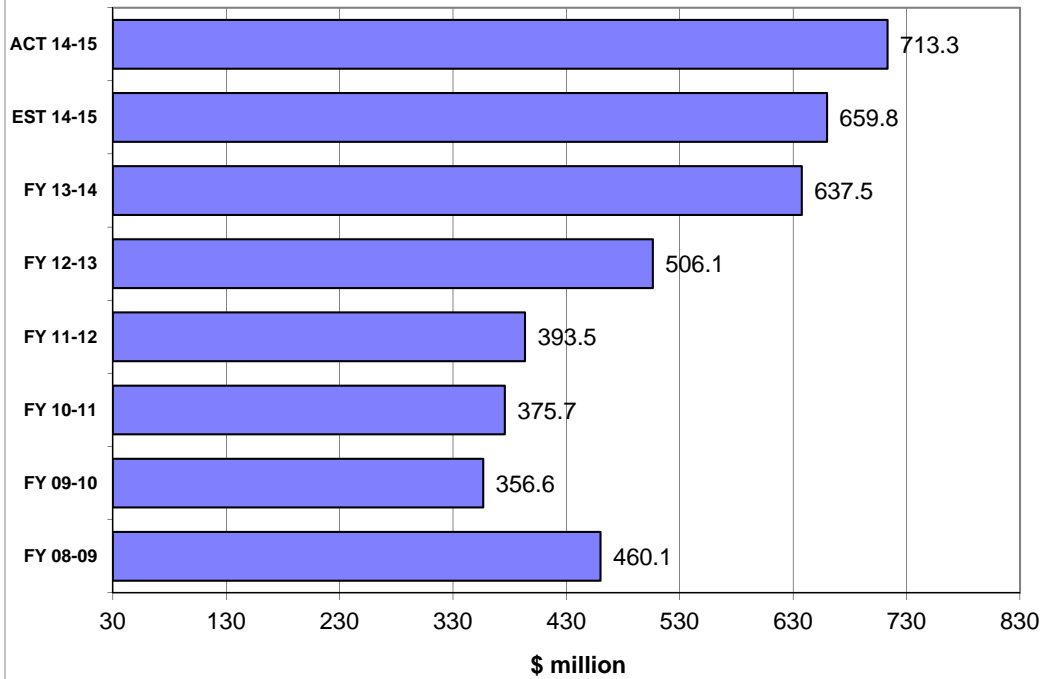




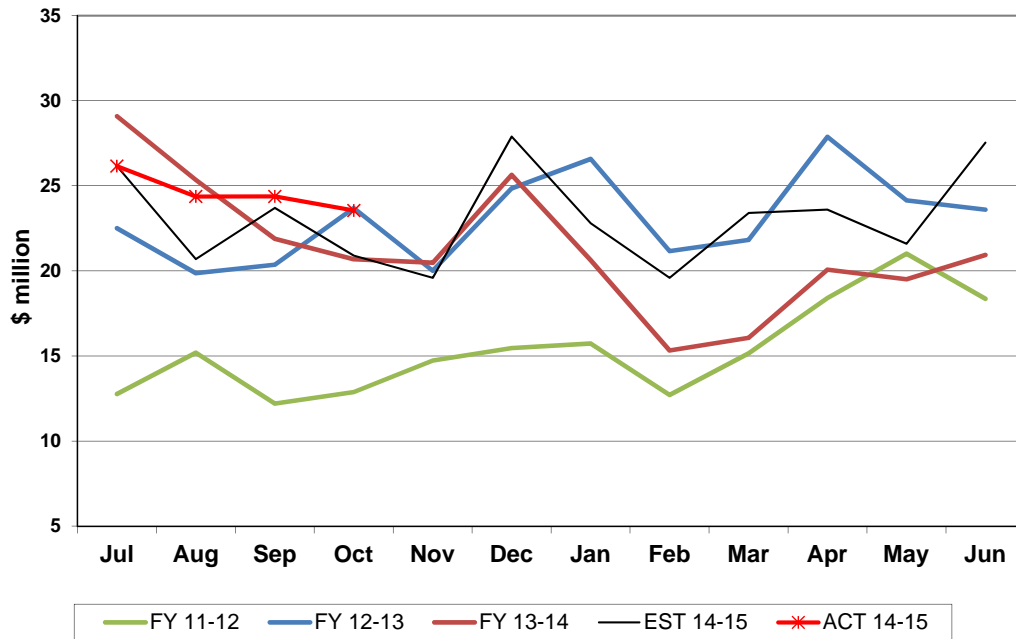
### Doc Stamps Tax Collections Monthly Receipts



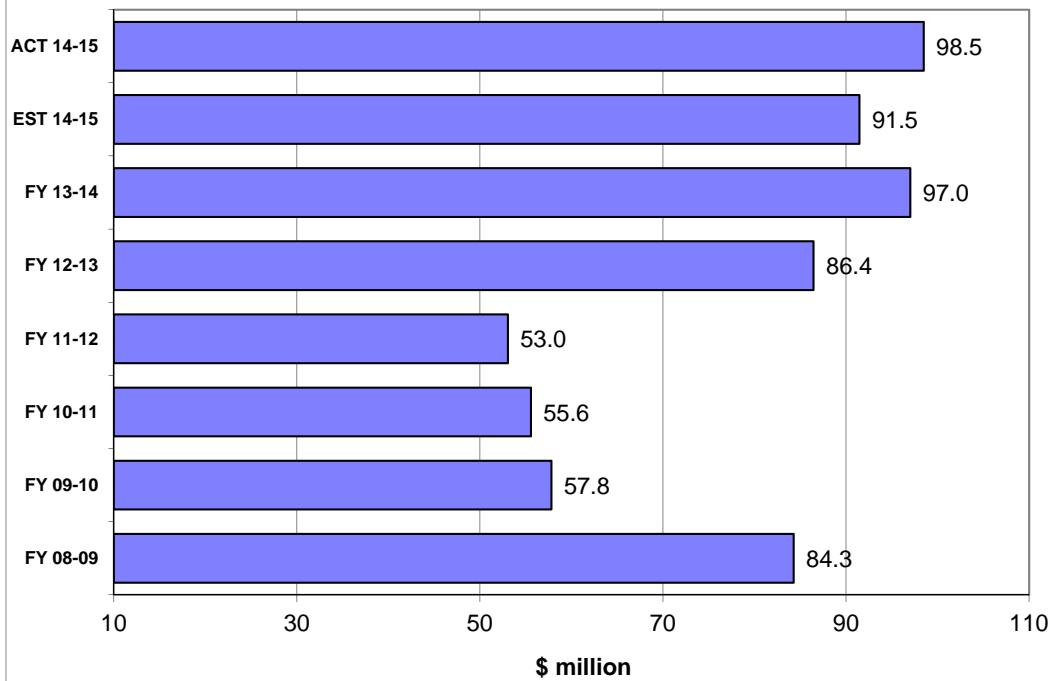
### Doc Stamps Tax Receipts Fiscal Years through October



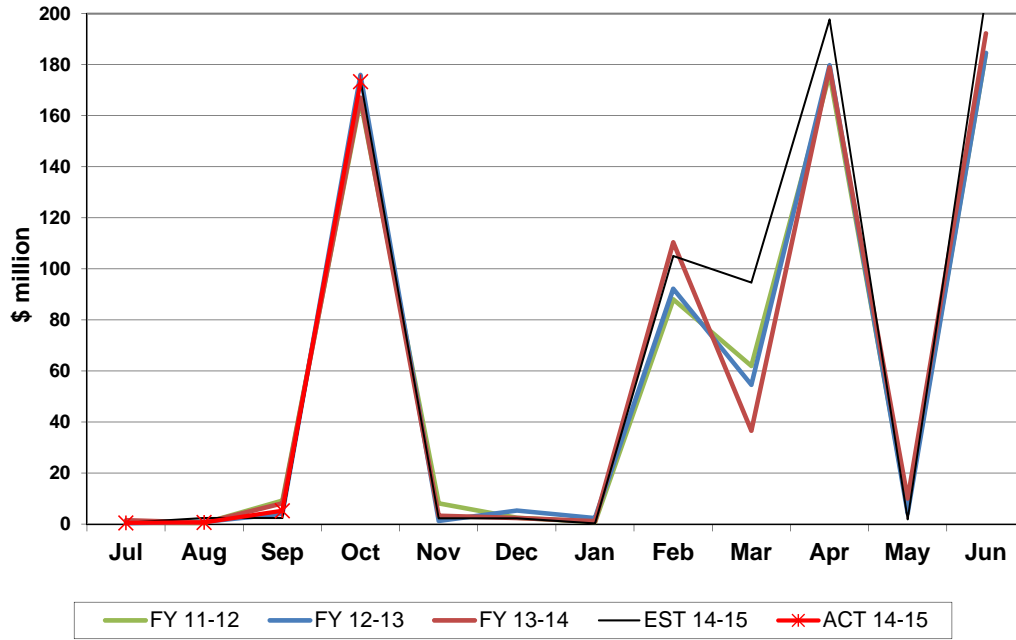
### Non-Recurring Intangible Tax Collections Monthly Receipts



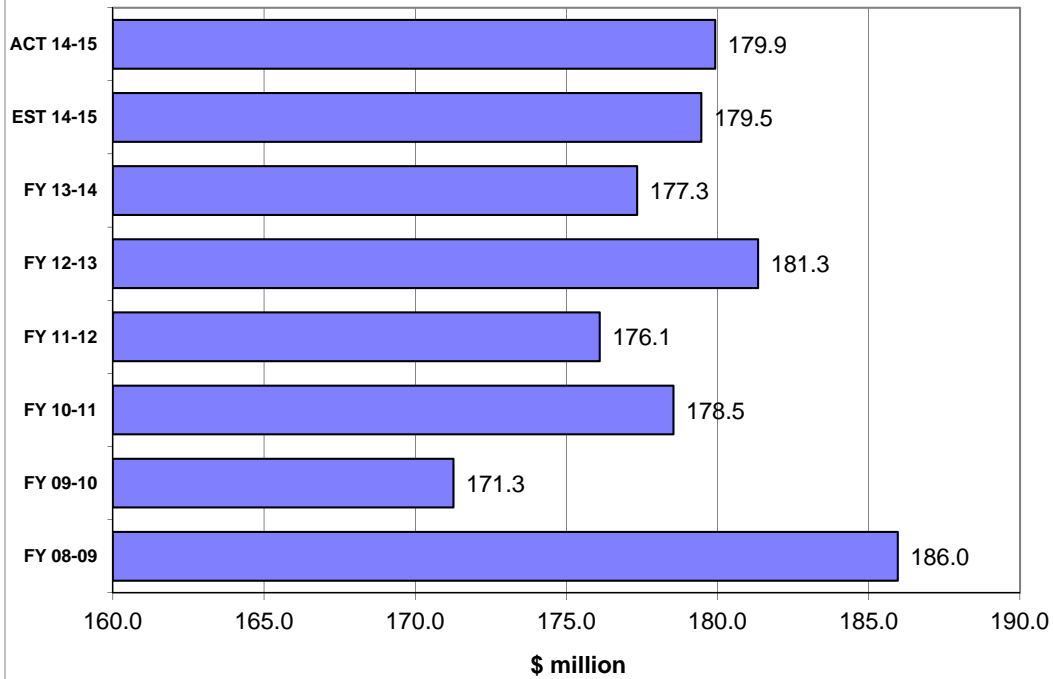
### Non-Recurring Intangible Tax Receipts Fiscal Years through October



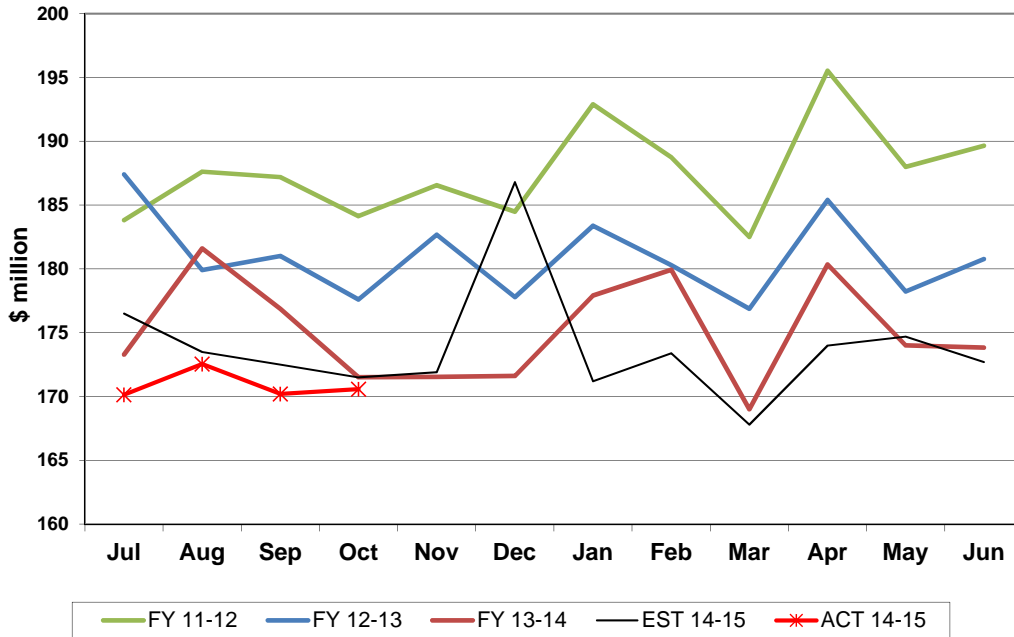
### Insurance Premium Tax Collections Monthly Receipts



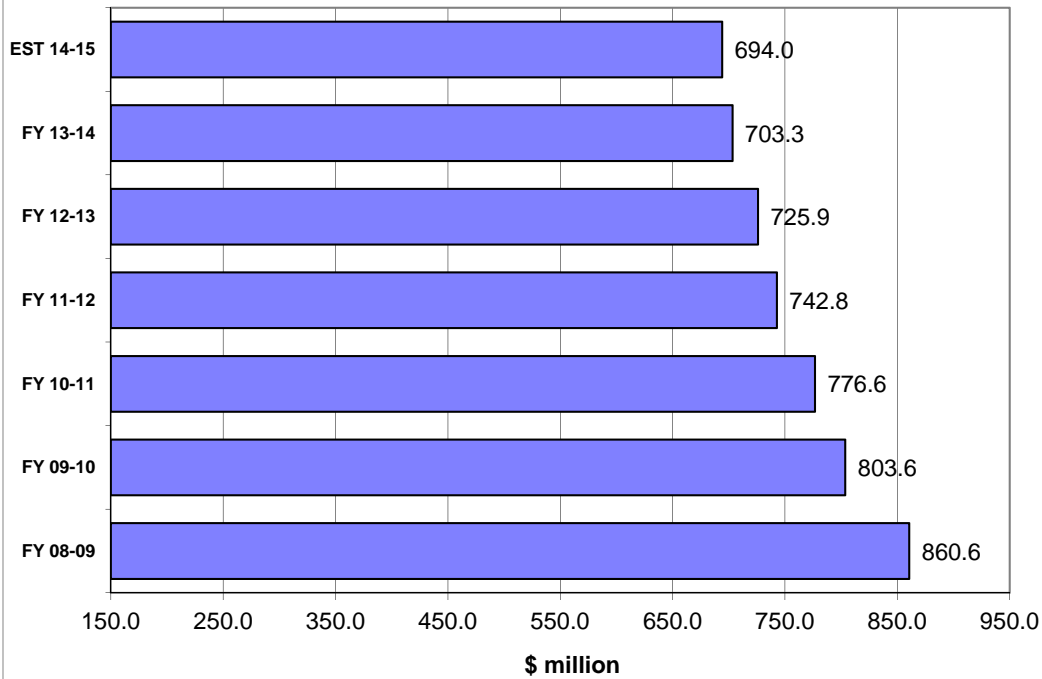
### Insurance Premium Tax Receipts Fiscal Years through October



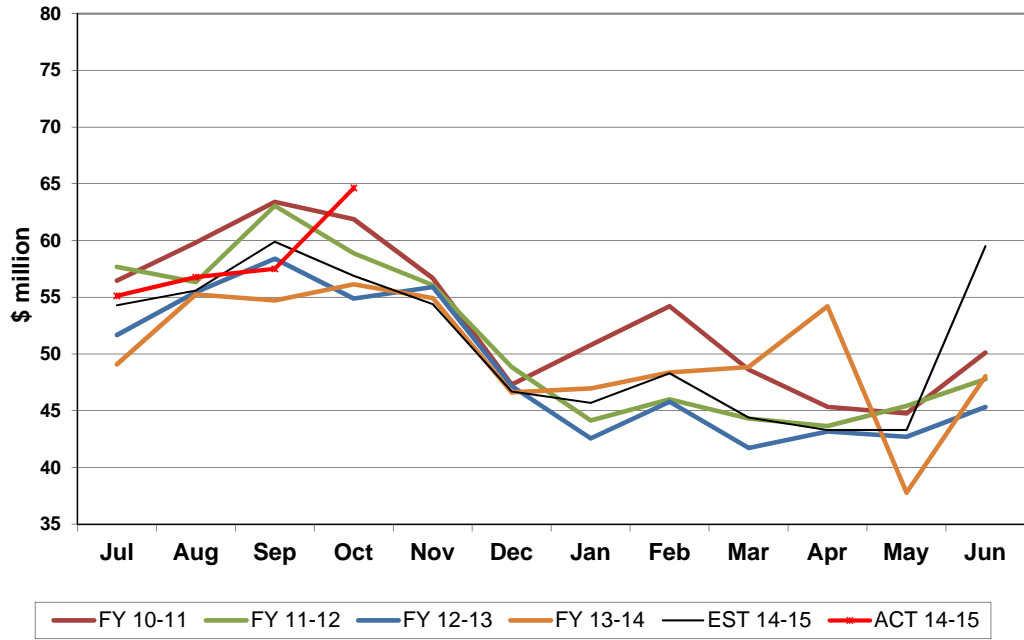
### Communication Services Tax Collections Monthly Receipts



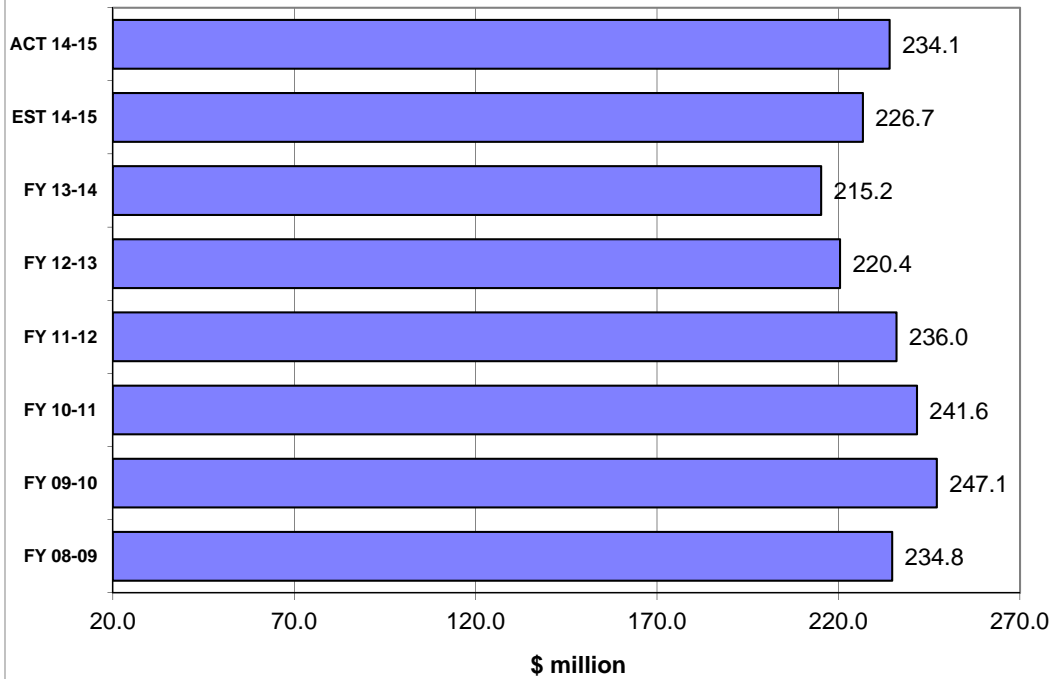
### Communication Services Tax Receipts Fiscal Years through October



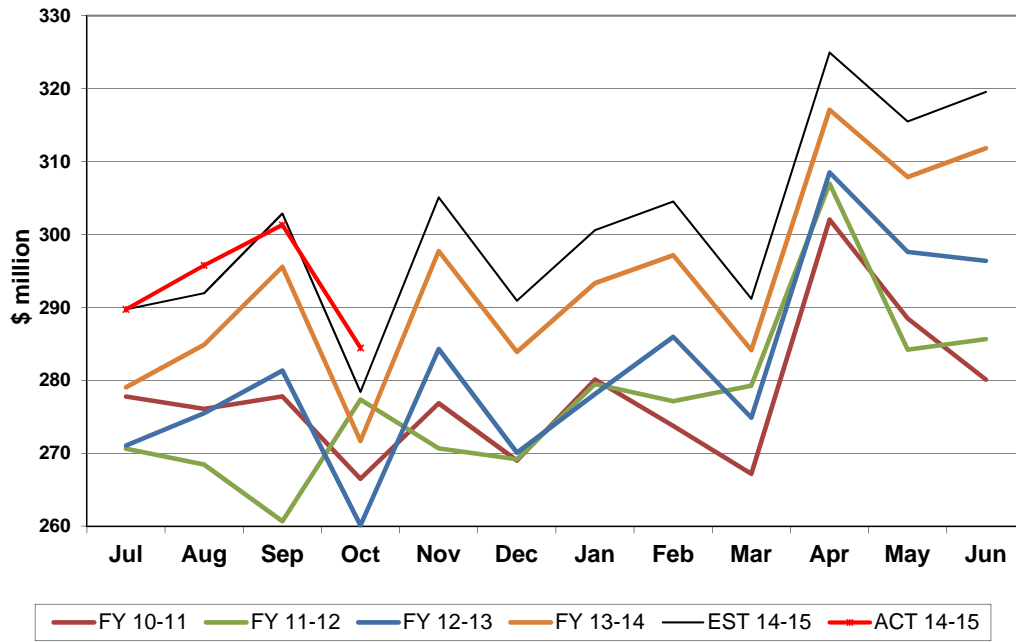
### 2.5% Gross Receipts Tax Collections Monthly Receipts



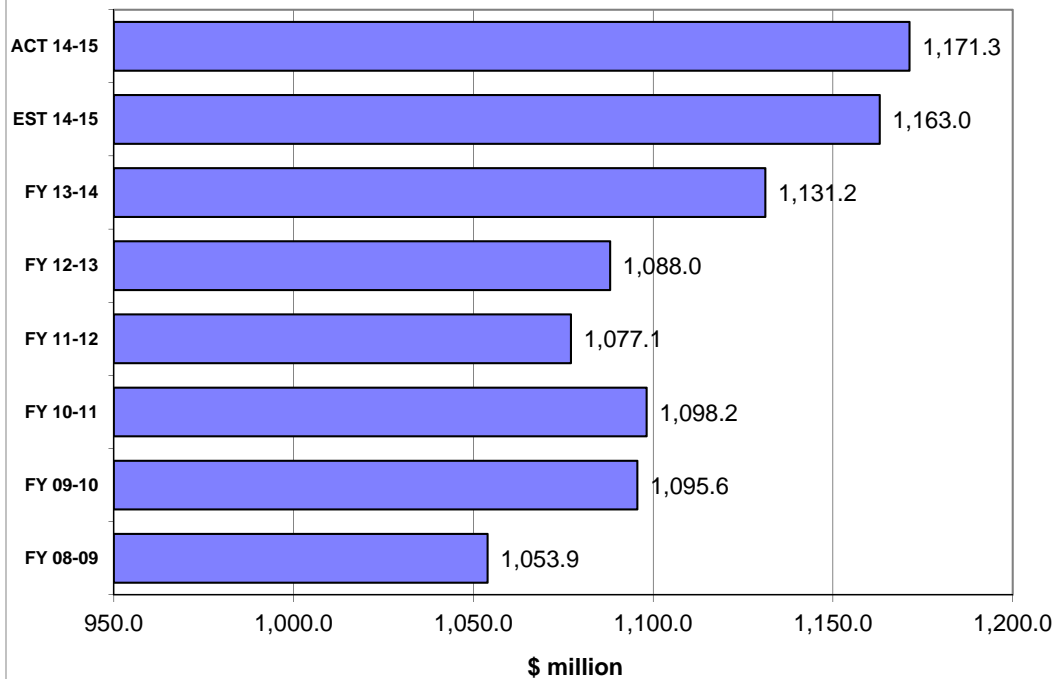

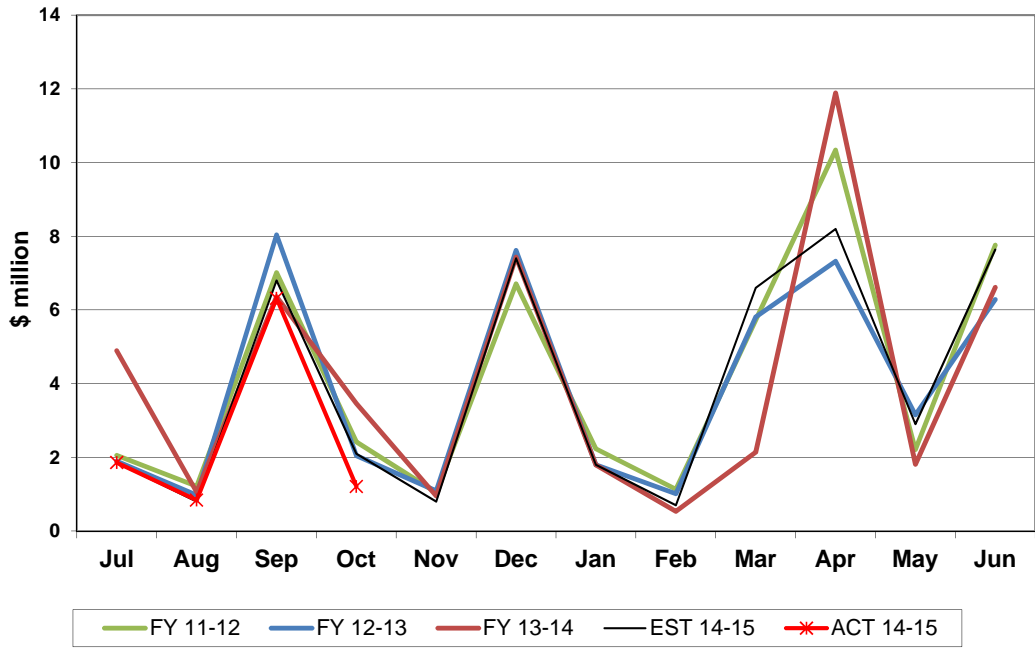
