**Real Property Recording Notification Service  
Exempt from Public Records**

PTO 24-04**

Effective May 6, 2024, Chapter 2024-149, Laws of Florida (CS/HB 285), amends section 28.47(5), Florida Statutes (F.S.), to exempt from disclosure under the public records law all e-mail addresses, telephone numbers, personal and business names, and parcel identification numbers submitted to the clerk of court or the property appraiser by a person registering for a recording notification service or a related service, except upon court order. This applies to information held by the clerk of court or property appraiser before, during, or after the implementation of the bill.
