WHAT IS PATERNITY?

Paternity means fatherhood. It involves identifying the legal father of a child.

WHY IS PATERNITY IMPORTANT?

Paternity gives rights, benefits and privileges to the father, mother and child.

Some benefits include:

- Information about family medical history
- Health and life insurance, if available
- Social Security or veteran's benefits, military allowances and inheritances
- The father's name will be on the birth certificate

AT BIRTH

BY MARRIAGE

WITH AN ACKNOWLEDGMENT
(SIGNED BY BOTH PARENTS IN OUR OFFICE)

WITH A LEGAL ORDER
(REQUIRES GENETIC TESTING)
