Genetic testing identifies a child's biological father.



WHEN WILL THE RESULTS BE READY?



Results are mailed about 2 weeks after the last sample is taken. Results can also be shared over the phone, chat or email.

WHAT DO THE RESULTS MEAN?

The results show if the person tested is the biological father.

ONCE A FATHER IS IDENTIFIED, WHAT'S NEXT?

- A final order of paternity is issued.
- The child's birth certificate is updated with the father's name.
