SALES AND USE TAX

Sales and Use Tax collections were \$3,840.1m in August, and above the August 2024 collections by \$199.8m (5.5%). Collections for Sales Tax include Local Option Sales Tax and 2.6% Gross Receipts. These receipts are from the perspective of department collections and do not reflect collections of other state entities.

CORPORATE INCOME TAX

CIT collections of \$82.3m in August 2025 were under the August 2024 collections by \$9.9m (-10.8%). These receipts are from the perspective of department collections and do not reflect collections of other state entities.

DOCUMENTARY STAMP TAX

Documentary Stamp Tax collections of \$314.2m were above the August 2024 collections by \$0.2m (0.1%). These receipts are from the perspective of department collections and do not reflect collections of other state entities.

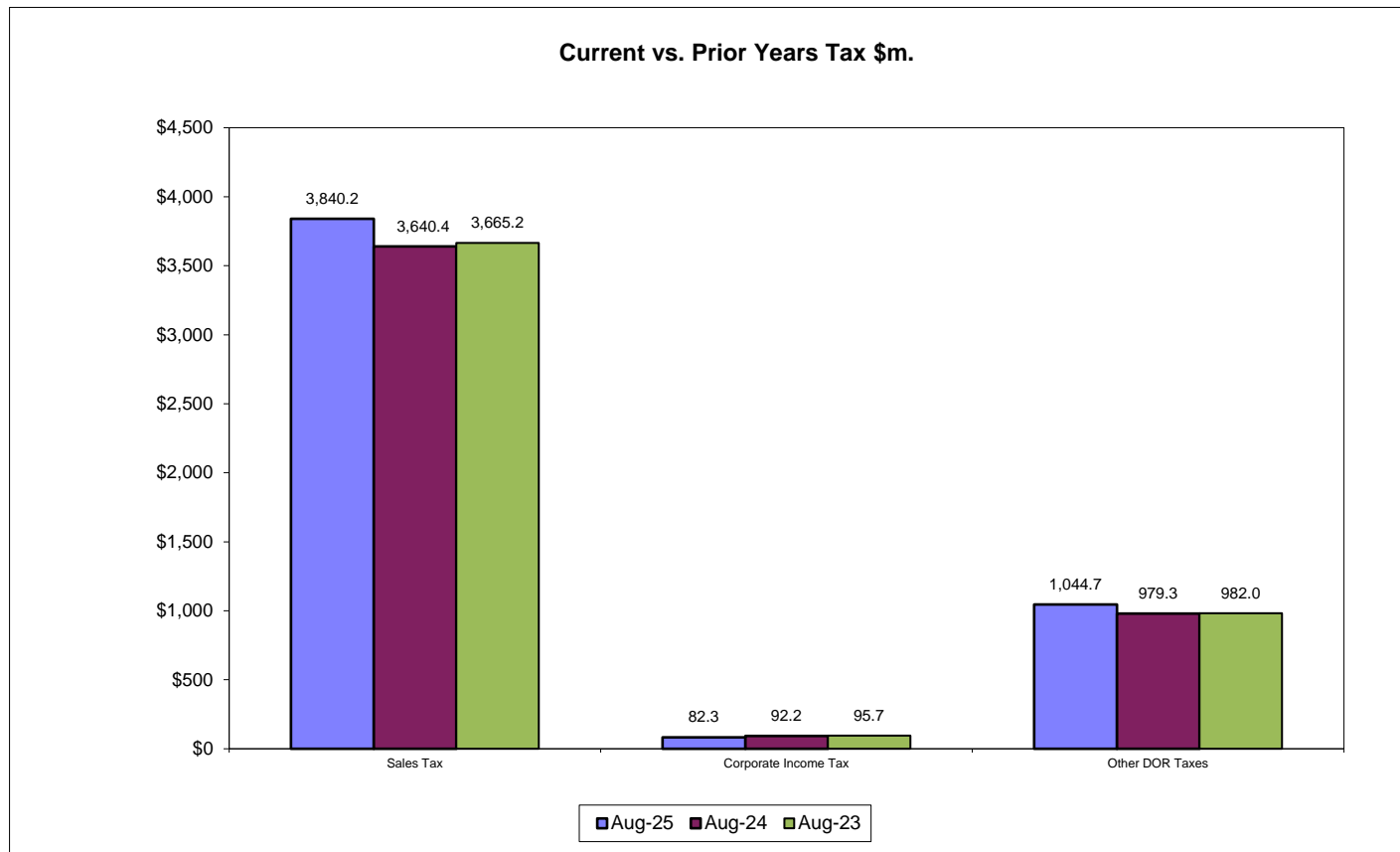

OTHER DOR TAXES...

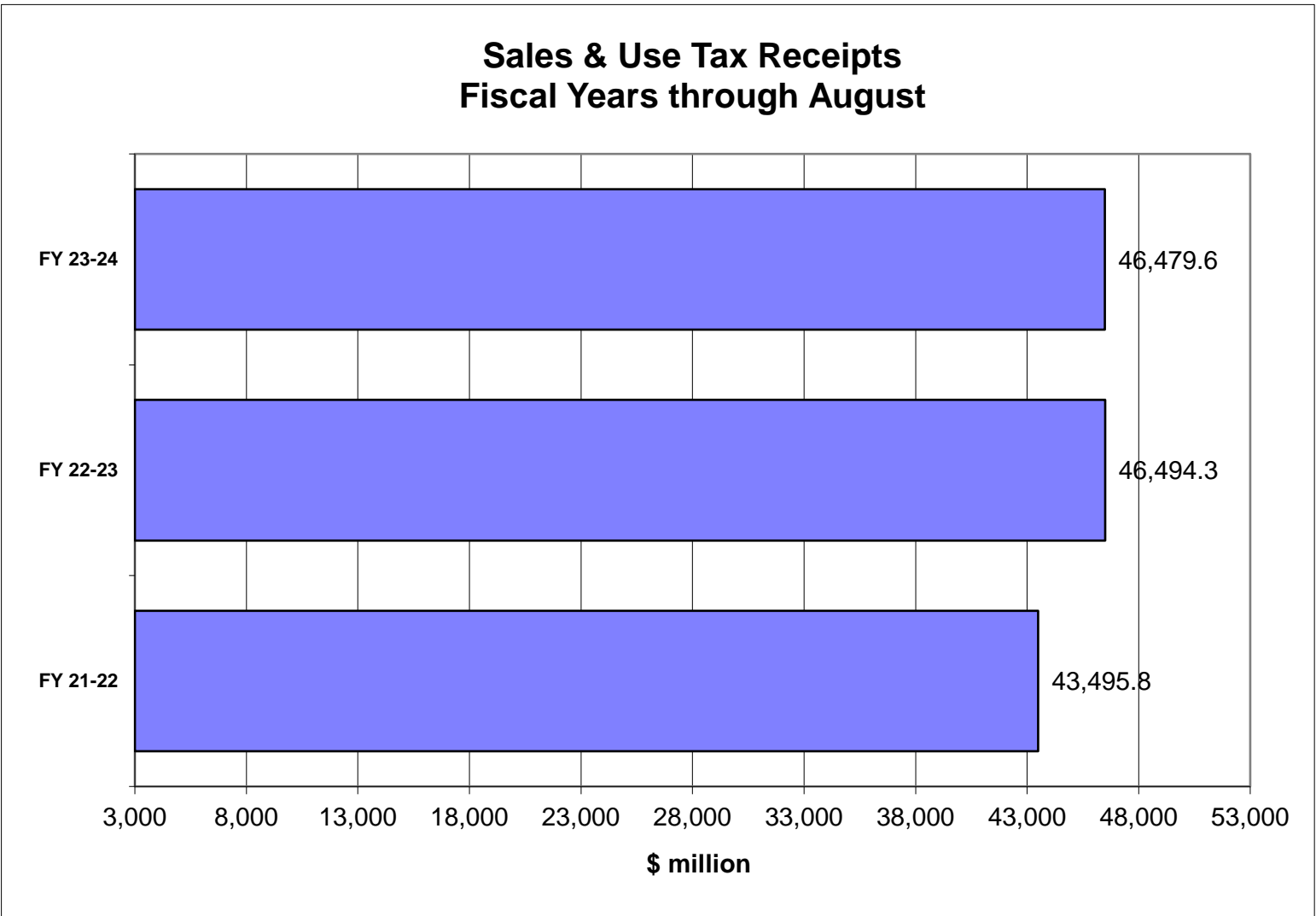
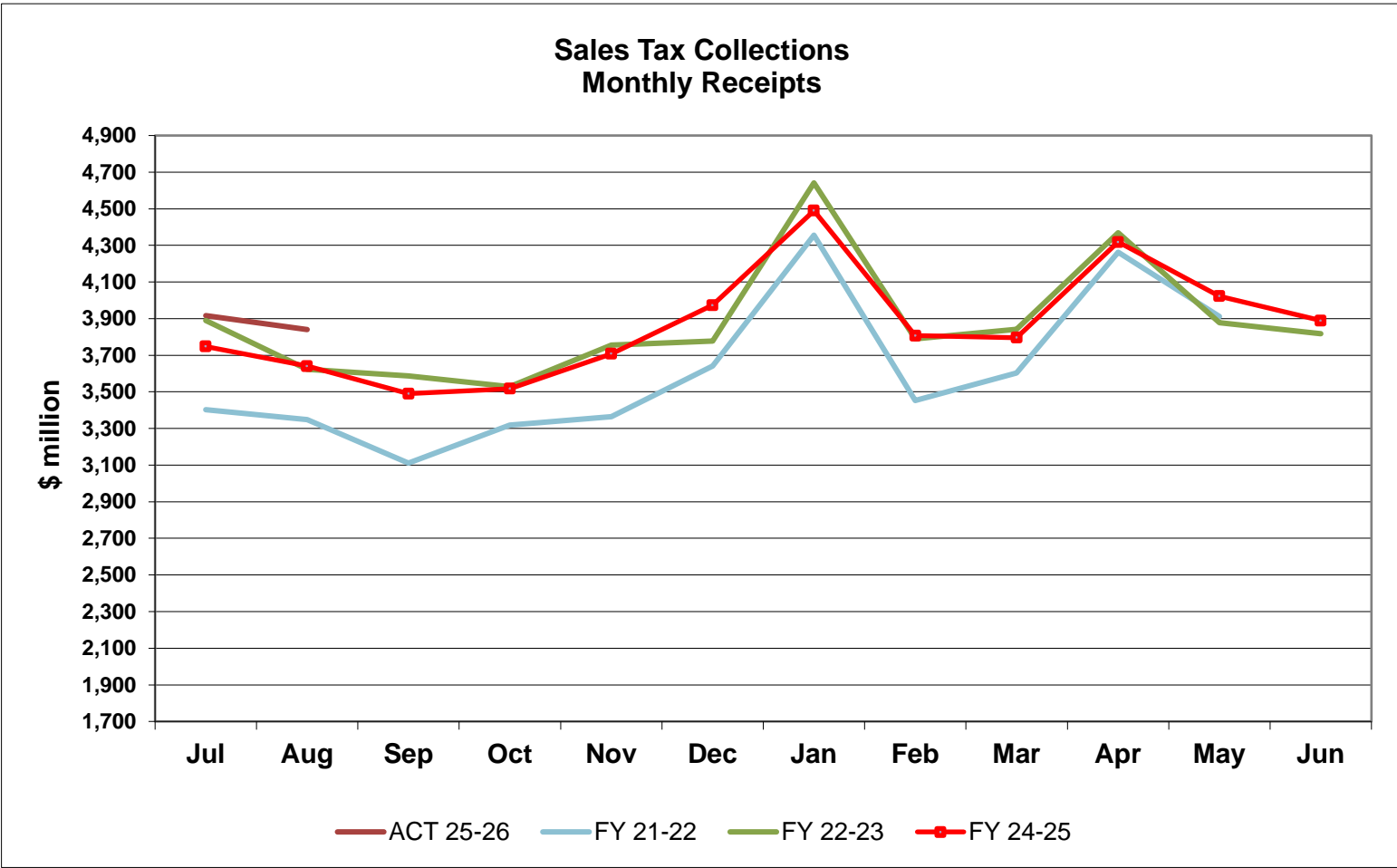
...excluding Sales Tax and Corporate Income Tax, other taxes contributed \$1044.7m to DOR tax collections in August 2025. The August 2025 collections were \$65.4m (6.7%) above the same month previous year's collections. The Doc Stamp Collections in August 2025 were \$314.2m. Compared to August 2024 collections on Doc Stamp Taxes, the August 2025 collections were \$0.2m (0.1%) above.

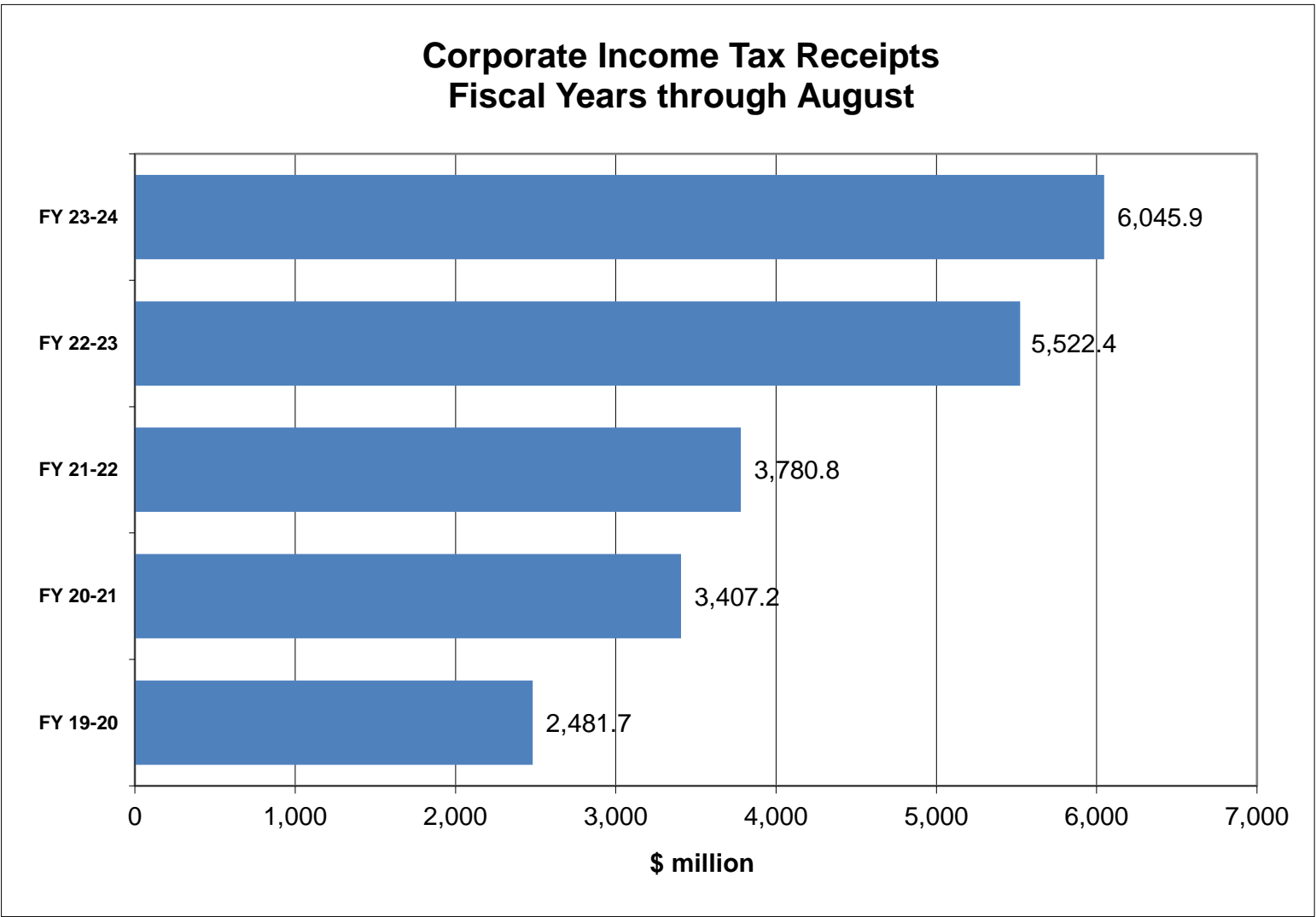
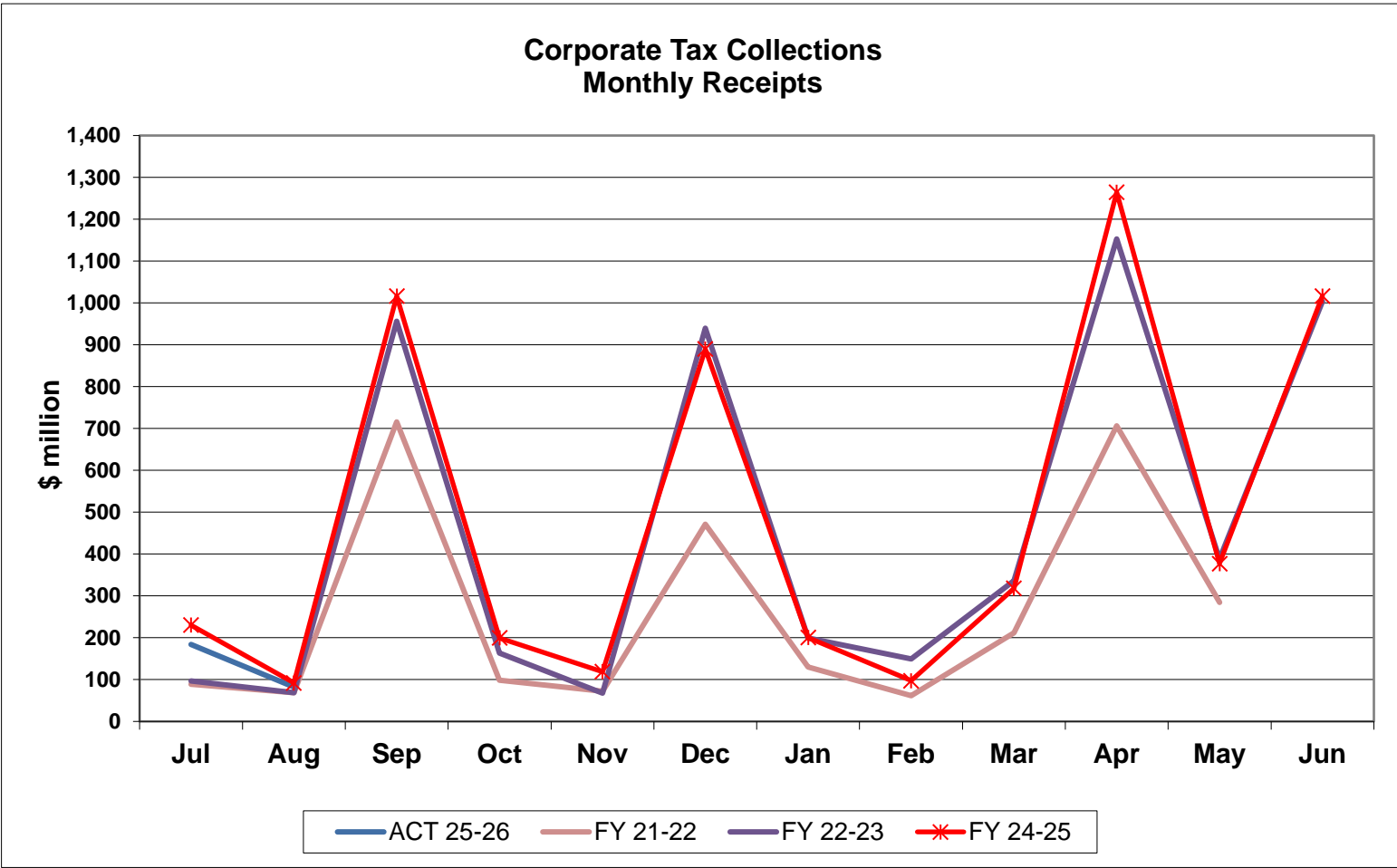
The August 2025 collections of the Communications Services Tax compared to August 2024 collections were \$7m (4.8%) above. The collections of Insurance Premium Tax in August were 2.1m. Compared to August 2024 collections on Insurance Premium Taxes, the August 2025 collections were \$0.1m (4.7%) above. The collections of Fuel-related Taxes & Fees in August were above the prior year by \$36.9m (9.4%). The non-recurring Intangible Tax collections were \$0m (0%) below the prior year.

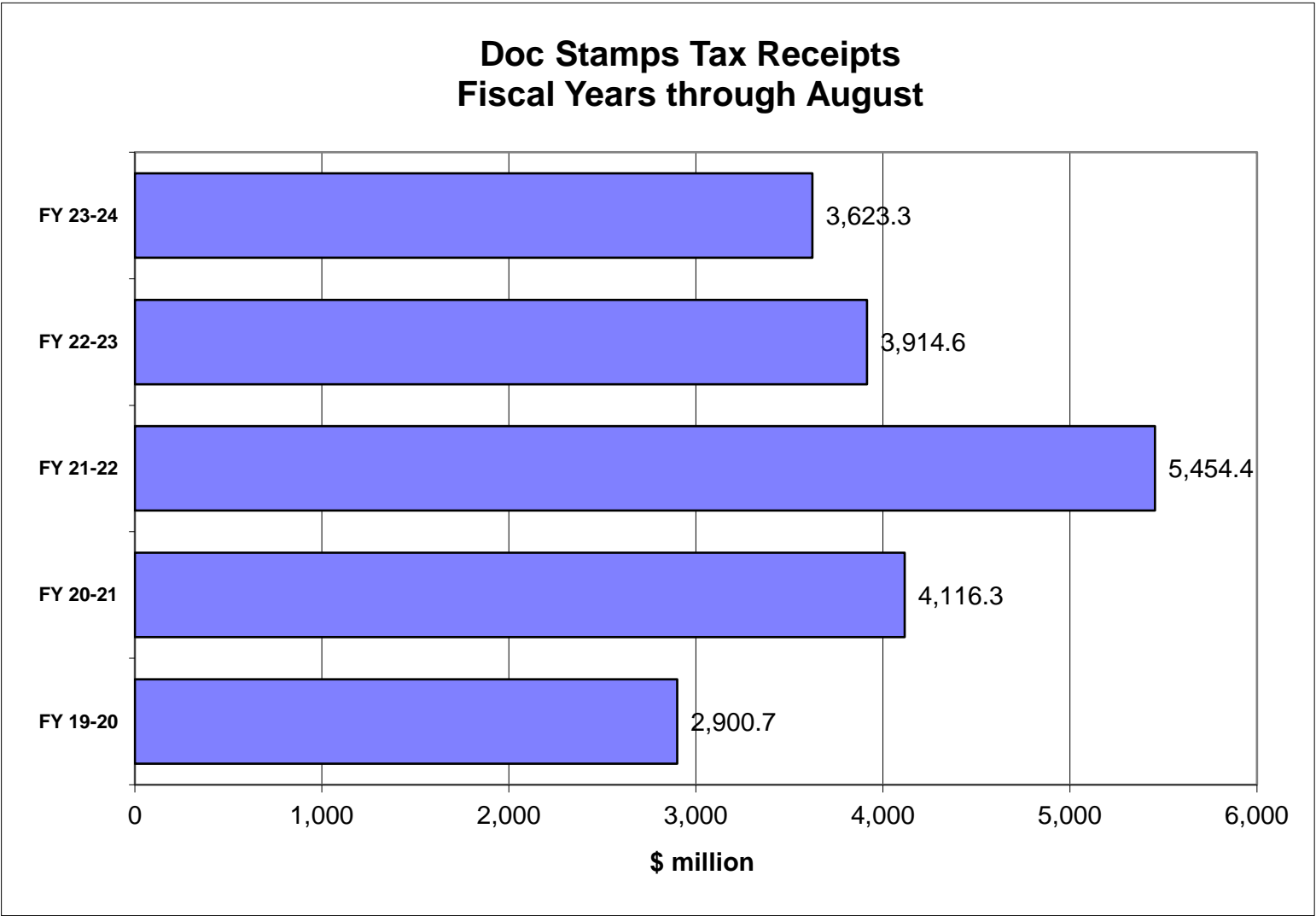
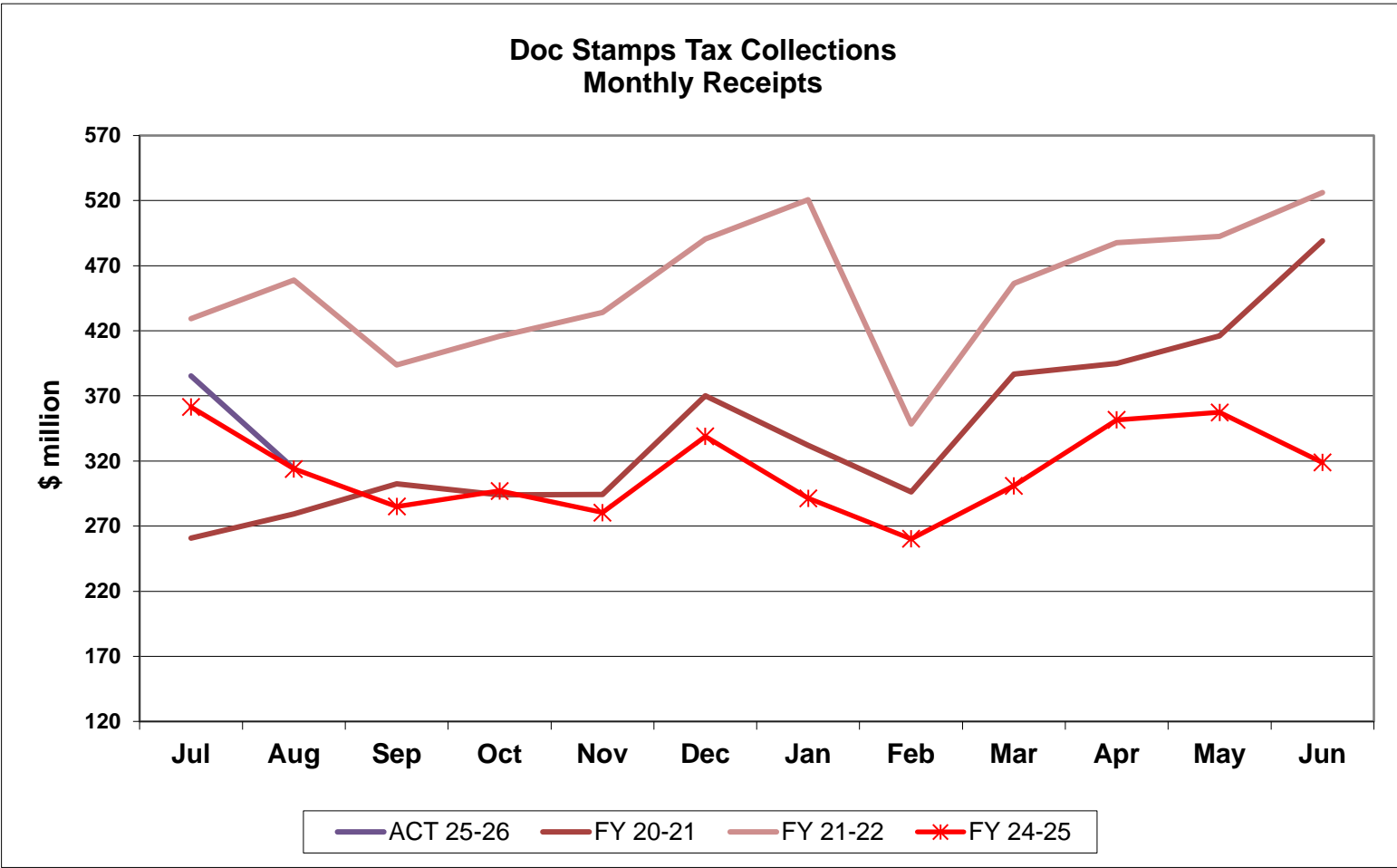


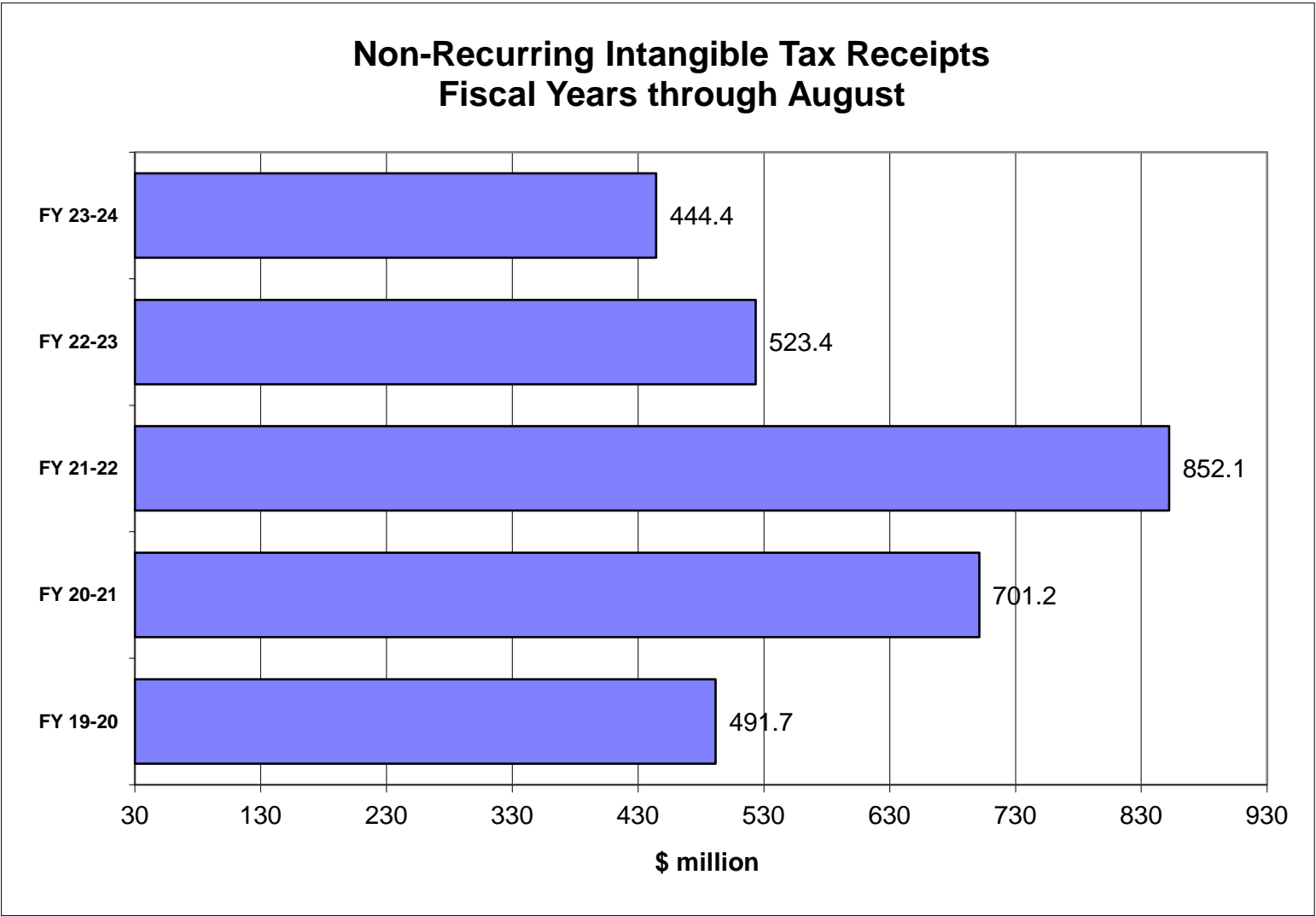
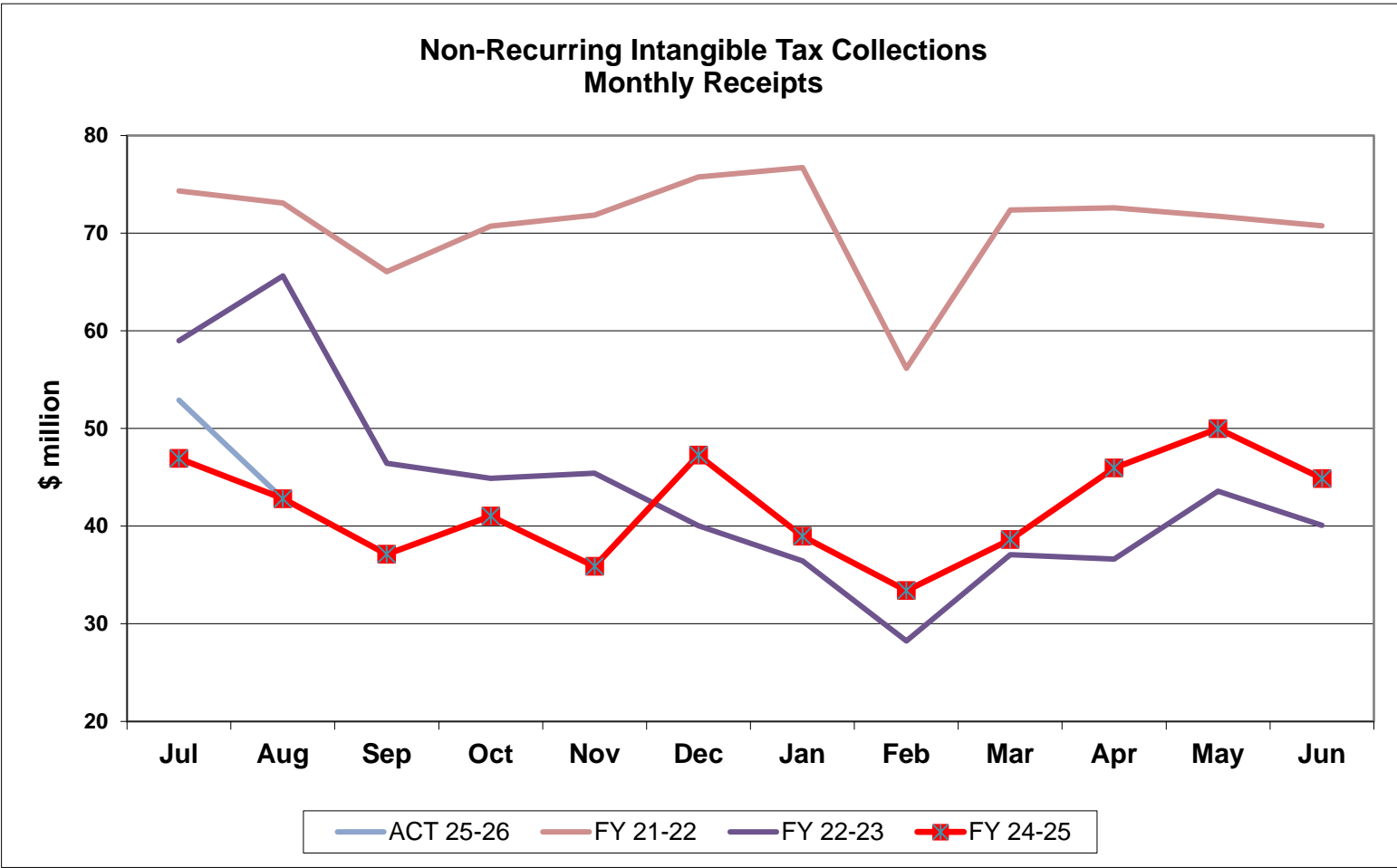
HISTORICAL COMPARISON GRAPHS

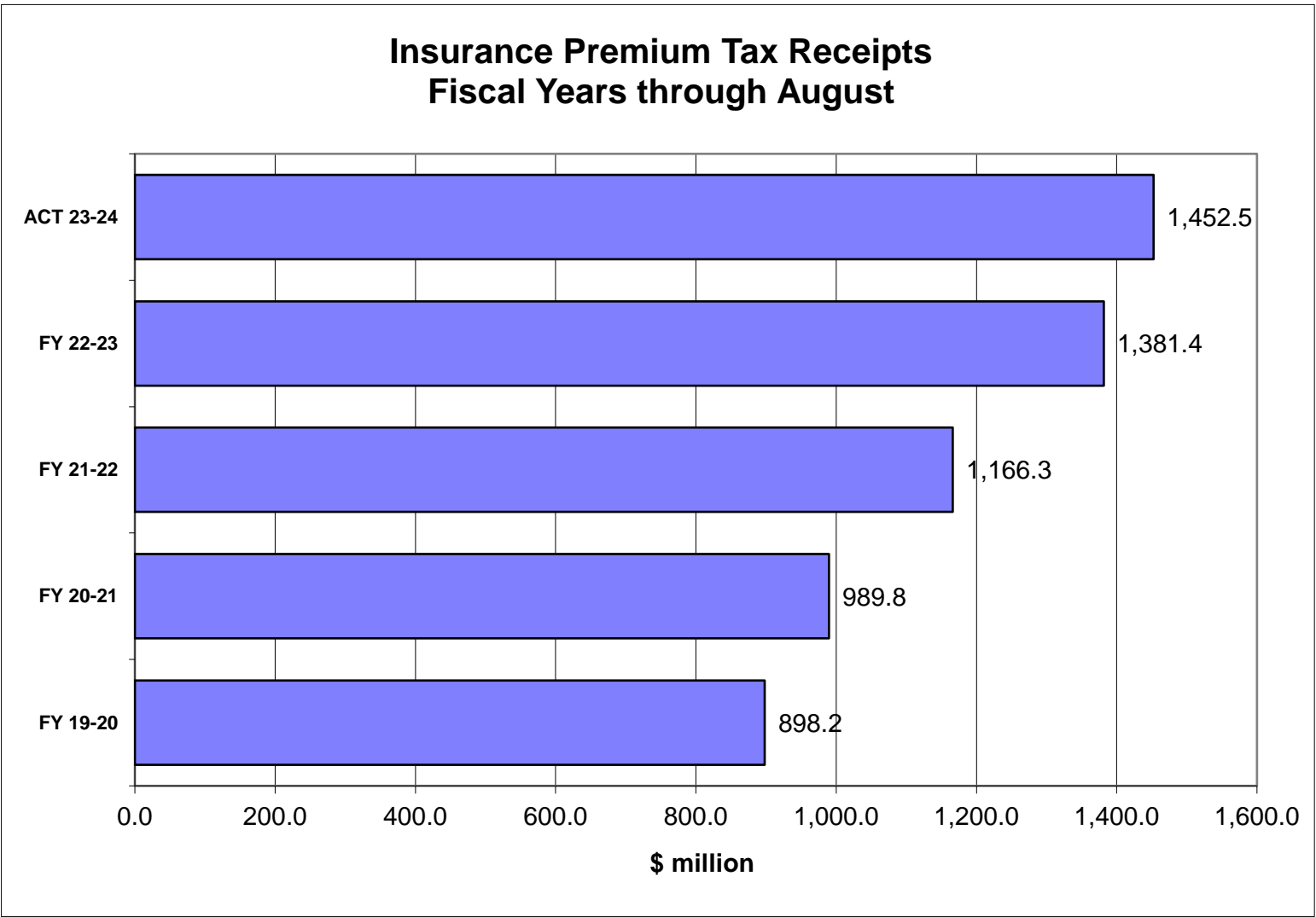
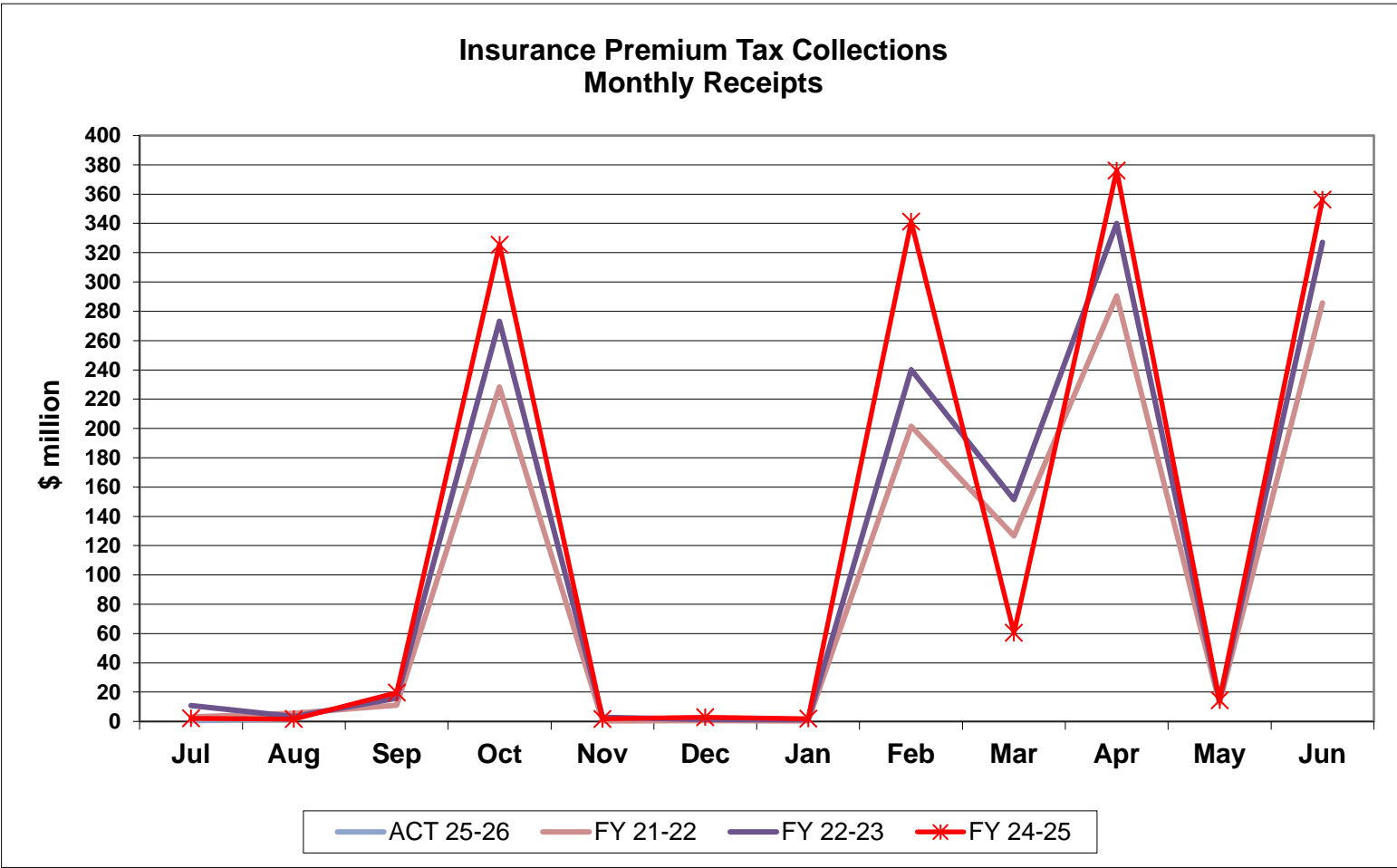

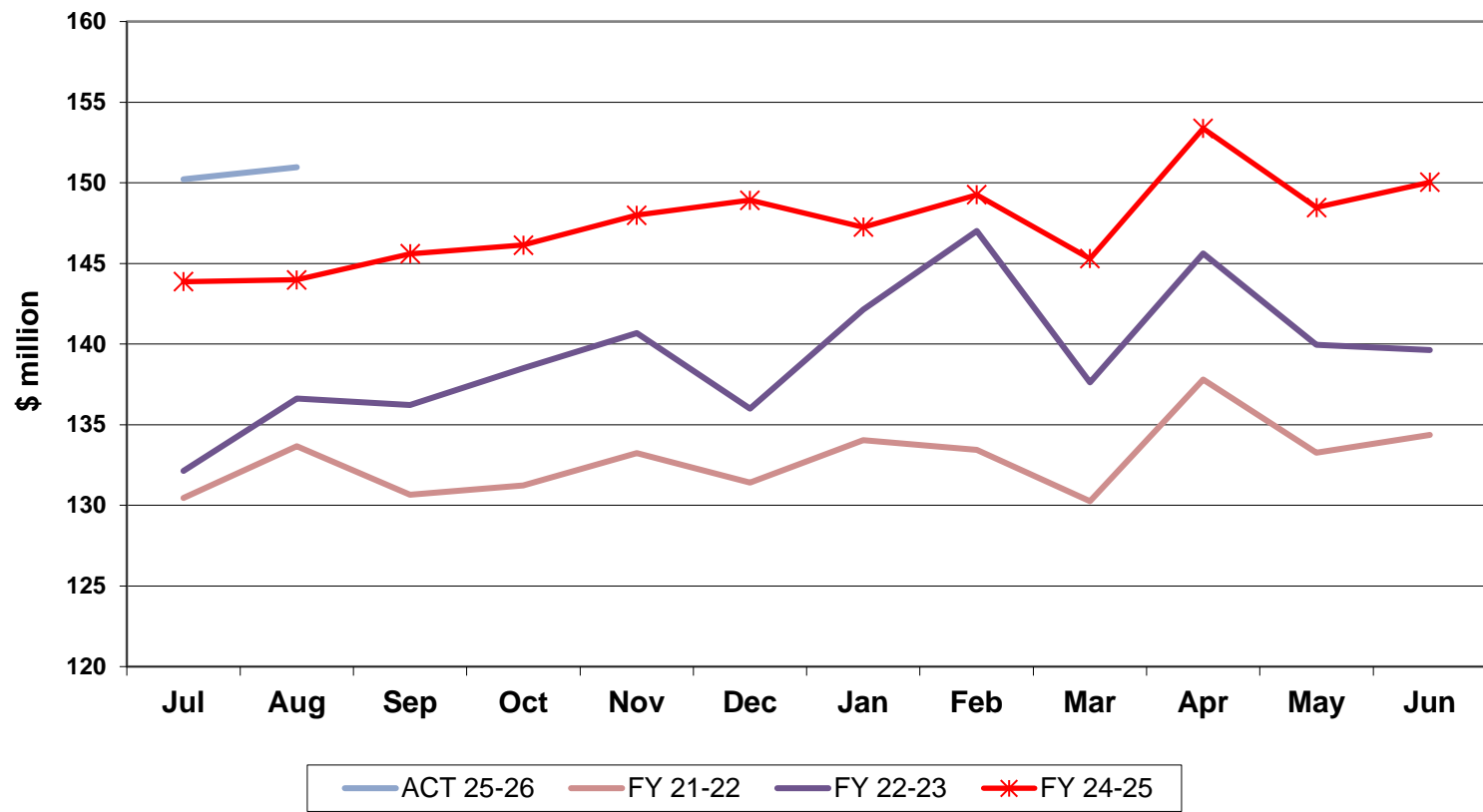




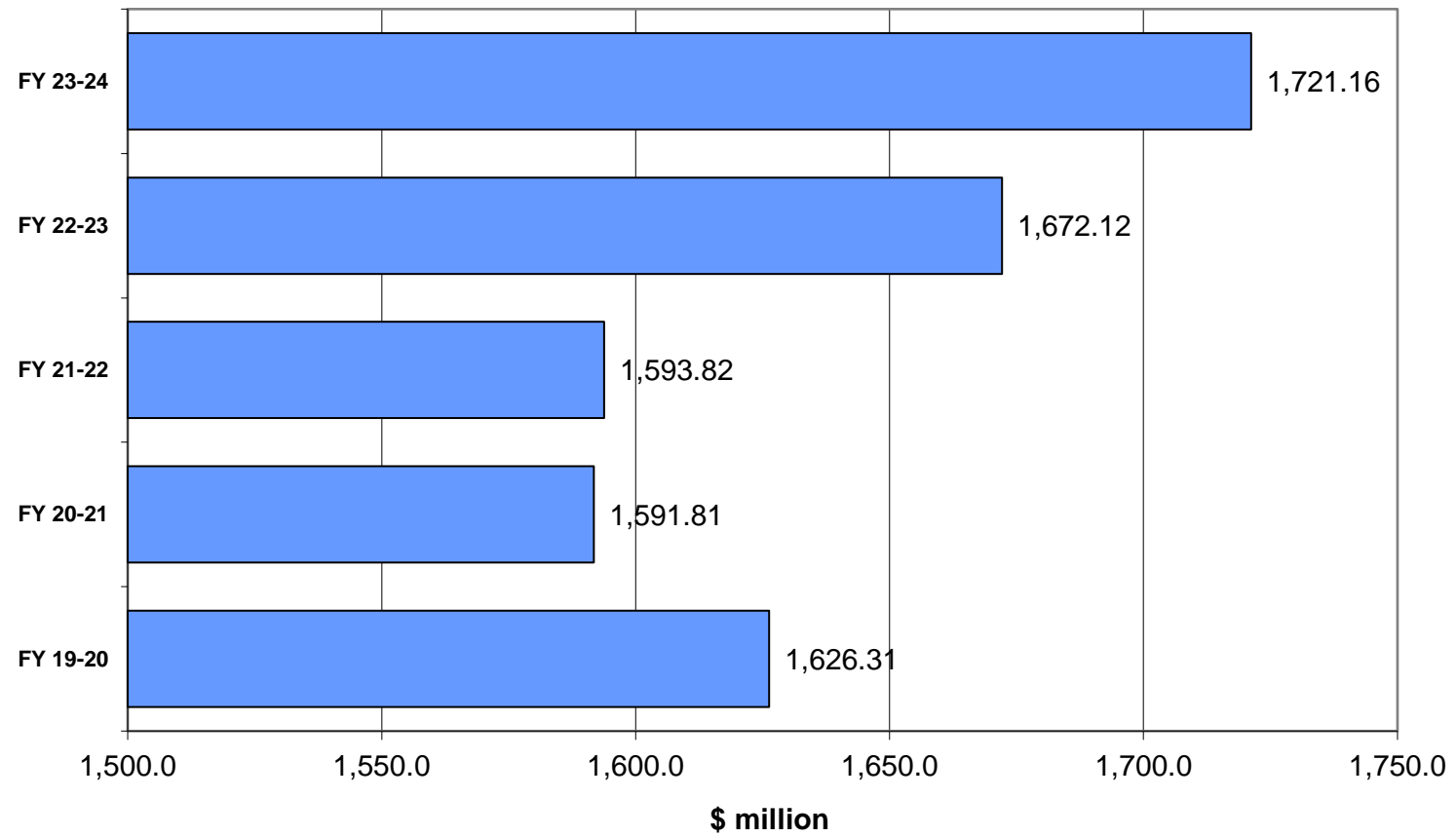


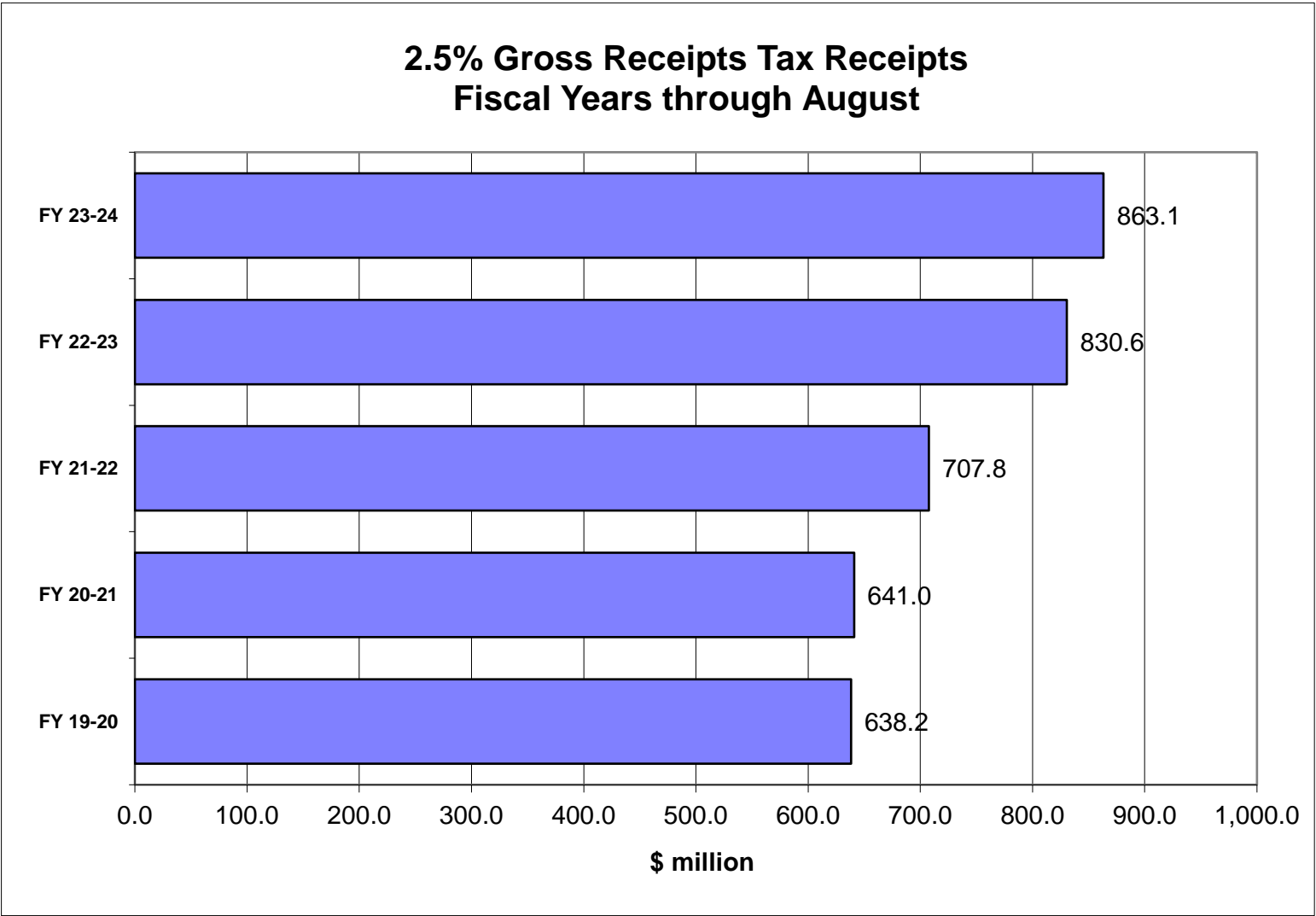
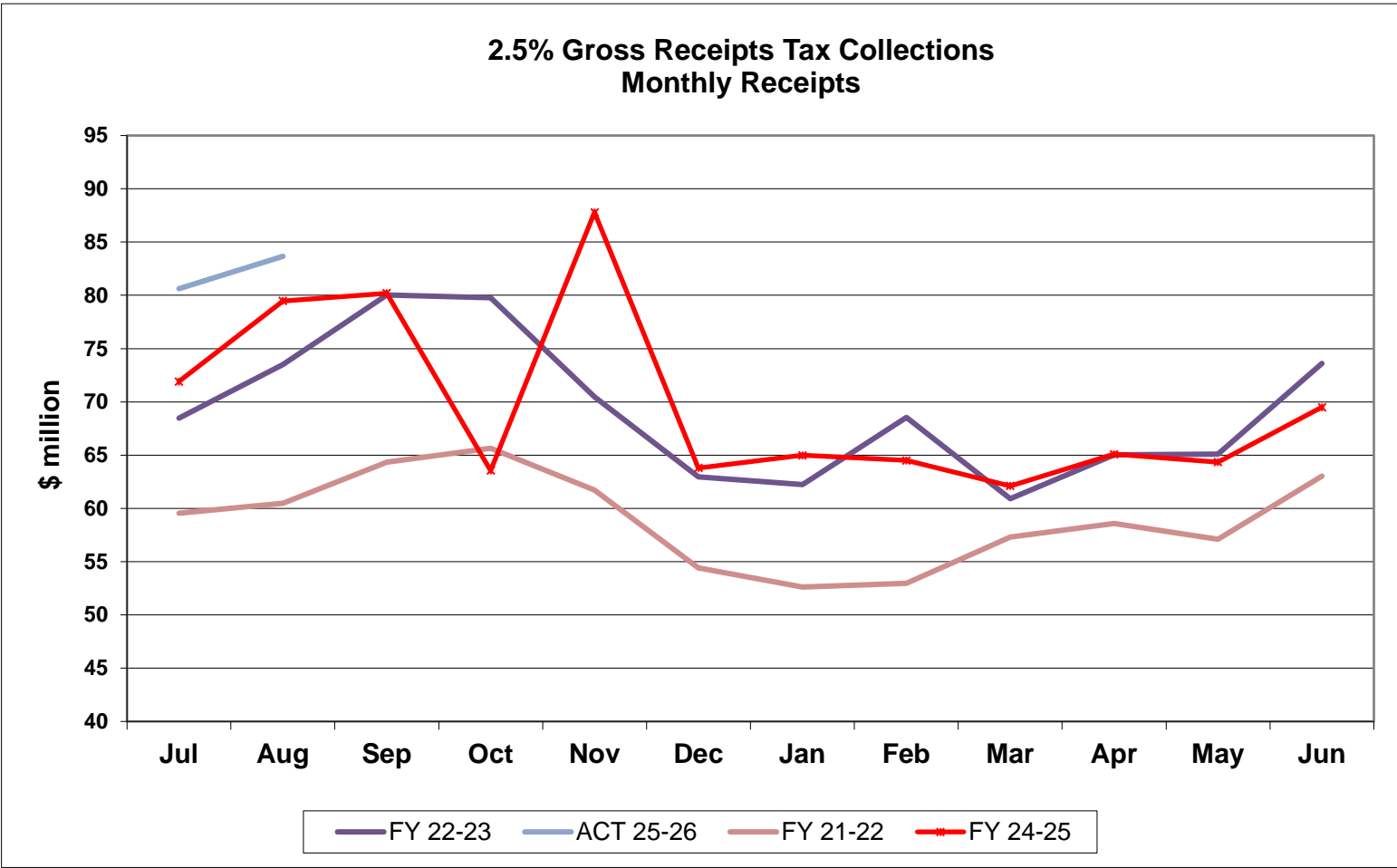


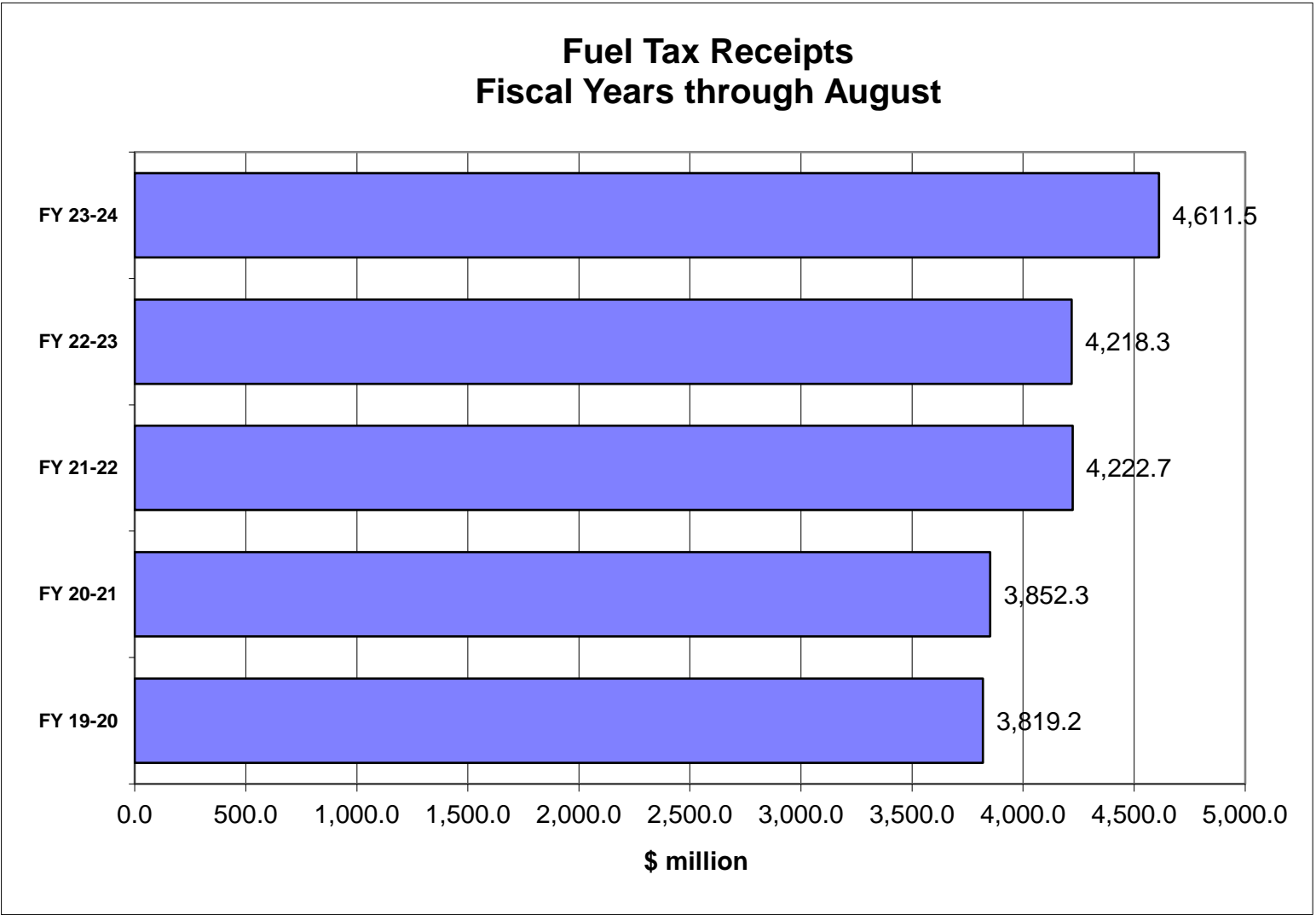
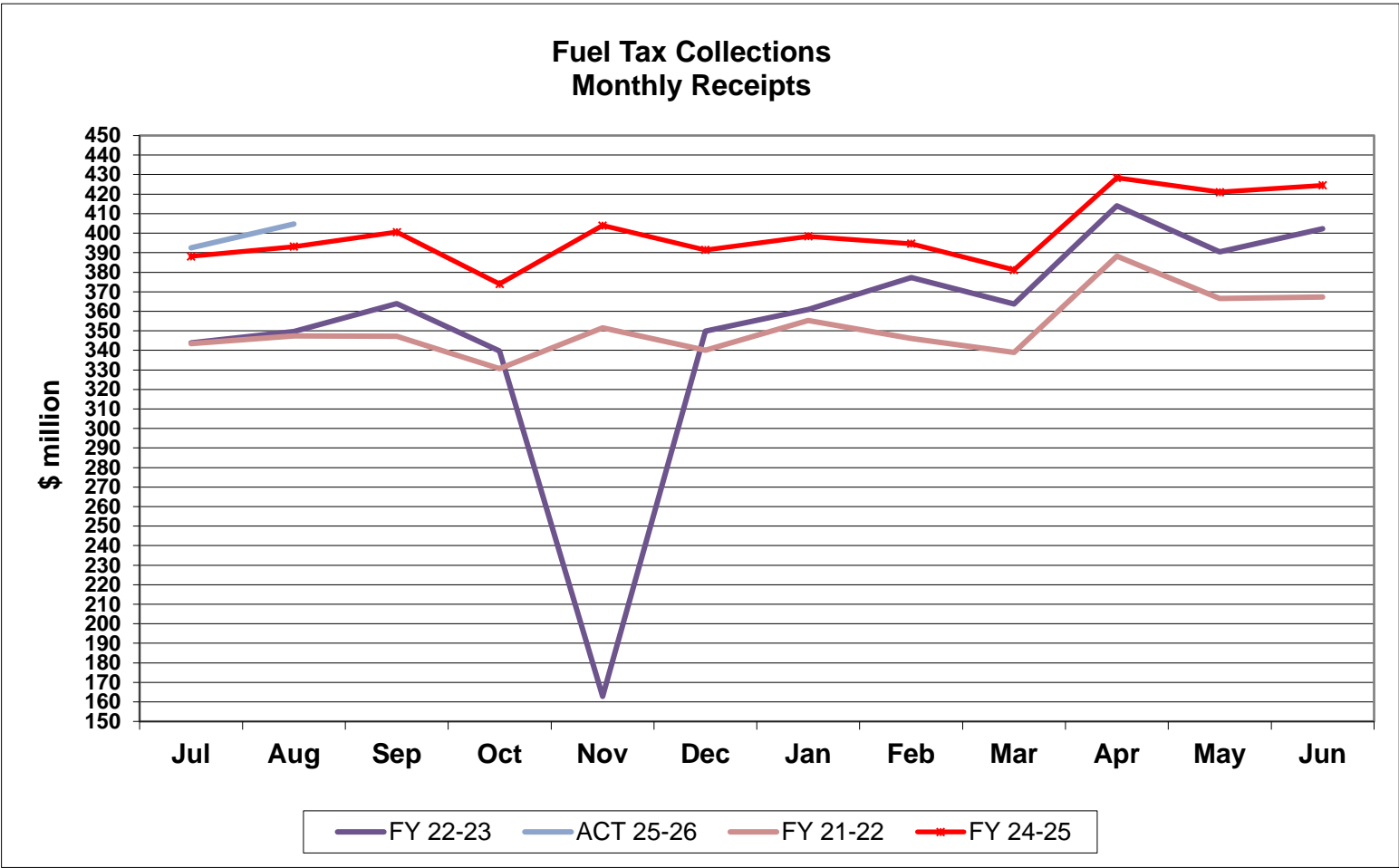
**Communication Services Tax Collections
Monthly Receipts**



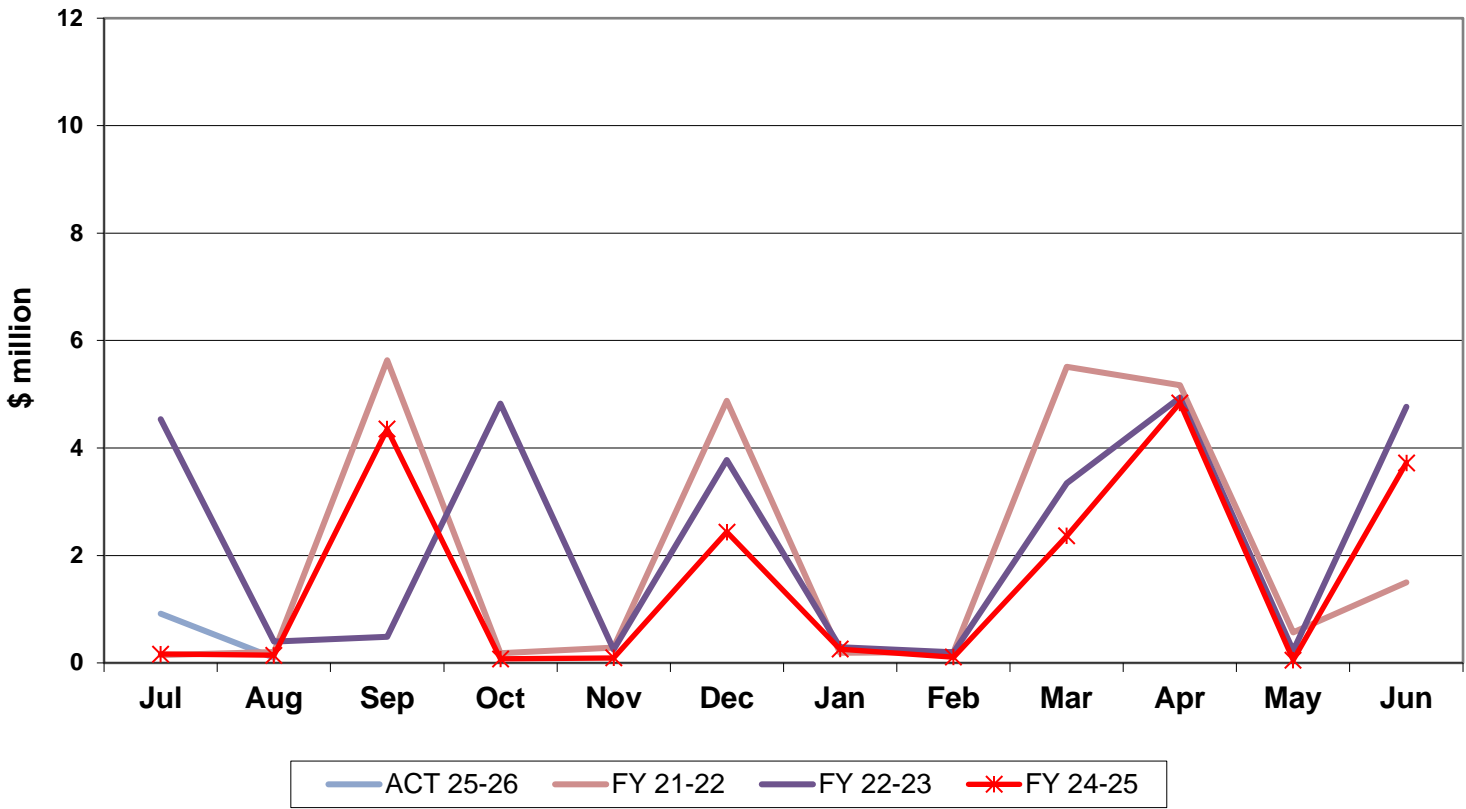
**Communication Services Tax Receipts
