



# APPLICATION TO OFFSET TOTAL REDUCTIONS IN AD VALOREM TAX REVENUE FROM REFUNDS DUE TO HURRICANE IAN OR HURRICANE NICOLE

By October 1, 2023, affected taxing jurisdictions must apply to the Department of Revenue for a distribution to offset the reduction in ad valorem tax revenues refunded to taxpayers due to Hurricane Ian or Hurricane Nicole in accordance with s. 197.3181, F.S. See section 50 of Chapter 2023-157, Laws of Florida.

Attach a copy of Form DR-5003, *Report of Total Reductions in Taxes from Hurricane Ian or Hurricane Nicole*, as reported by the county tax collector, required under s. 197.3181(5)(b), F.S. The form will list the reduction in ad valorem tax revenues that affected the taxing jurisdiction. Provide any additional documentation to support the reduction in ad valorem tax revenue, if applicable. (Form DR-5003, is incorporated by reference in Rule 12D-16.002, F.A.C.)
