Rule 12A-19.100 Public Use Forms

Dear Ms. Jackson:

In accordance with section 120.54(3)(d)1., F.S., this letter serves as notification to the Joint Administrative Procedures Committee that the referenced rule has not changed from publication of the Notice of Proposed Rule published in the *Florida Administrative Register* on December 20, 2023 (Vol. 49, No. 245, pp. 4677-4682). The notice provided that, if requested in writing, a rule hearing would be scheduled. No request was received, and no hearing was held.

The Department reviewed the proposed rule listed above and determined that the proposed rule will not likely have an adverse impact on small businesses, small counties, or small cities, and it is not likely to have an increased regulatory cost in excess of \$200,000 within one year after the implementation of the rule. No Statement of Estimated Regulatory Cost is required for the proposed rule. The rule does not require ratification by the Legislature pursuant to Section 120.541(3), F.S.

The Department requests that the Committee file its certification with the Administrative Code and Register on January 18, 2024. With your approval, the Department will file the proposed rule for adoption on January 18, 2024, not more than 90 days after publication of the notice, for an effective date of February 7, 2024.
