Dear Ms. Holladay:

In accordance with section 120.54(3)(d)1., F.S., this letter serves as notification to the Joint Administrative Procedures Committee that the referenced rule has been changed from the proposed rule amendments published in the *Florida Administrative Register* on September 19, 2023 (Vol. 49, No. 182, pp. 3470-3471).

A Notice of Change for Rule 12B-8.003, F.A.C., was published in the *Florida Administrative Register* on November 13, 2023 (Vol. 49, No. 220, p. 4239-4240). Technical changes are included in the law implemented section of the certified rule.

The Department reviewed the proposed rule listed above and determined that the proposed rule likely will not have an adverse impact on small businesses, small counties, or small cities, and it is not likely to have an increased regulatory cost in excess of \$200,000 within one year. No Statement of Estimated Regulatory Cost is required for the proposed rule. The rule does not require ratification by the Legislature pursuant to Section 120.541(3), F.S.

The Department of Revenue will file the proposed rule amendment for certification with the Department of State on December 12, 2023, for an effective date of January 1, 2024. This rule is filed not more than 90 days after the notice.
