Please consider this letter as a replacement for the October 11, 2023, letter forwarded to the Joint Administrative Procedures Committee. In accordance with section 120.54(3)(d)1., F.S., this letter serves as notification to the Joint Administrative Procedures Committee that the referenced rules have been changed from the proposed rule amendments published in the *Florida Administrative Register* on May 30, 3023 (Vol. 49, No. 102, pp. 2025-2029).

A Notice of Change for Rule 12C-1.051, F.A.C., was published in the *Florida Administrative Register* on August 4, 2023 (Vol. 49, No. 151, p. 2876).

The Department reviewed the proposed rule listed above and determined that the proposed rule likely will not have an adverse impact on small businesses, small counties, or small cities, and it is not likely to have an increased regulatory cost in excess of \$200,000 within 1 year. No Statement of Estimated Regulatory Cost is required for the proposed rule. The rule does **not** require ratification by the Legislature pursuant to Section 120.541(3), F.S.

The Department of Revenue will file the proposed rule amendments for certification with the Department of State on October 25, 2023, for an effective date of November 14, 2023. Are filed more than 90 days after the notice, but not more than 45 days after the publication of the final Notice of Change.
