At their September 22, 2020, public meeting, the Governor and Cabinet approved the publication of the Notice of Proposed Rule and that the Department can file and certify the proposed rule for final adoption if no changes were made after the meeting.

The Notice of Proposed Rule was published in the Florida Administrative Register (F.A.R.) on September 24, 2020 (Vol. 46, No. 187, pp. 3984-3985) for *Rule 12D-16.002, Index to Forms*. The Department received a request to hold a hearing for this rule, and a hearing was held on October 27, 2020. No comments were received at the hearing and no written comments were received by the Department. There have been no changes to the version of the rule or incorporated materials that was published in the Florida Administrative Register on September 24, 2020.

The Department reviewed the proposed rule listed above and determined that the proposed rule likely will not adversely impact small businesses, small counties, or small cities, and they are not likely to have an increased regulatory cost greater than \$200,000 in the aggregate within one year after the implementation of the rule. No Statement of Estimated Regulatory Cost is required for the proposed rule. The rule does not require ratification by the Florida Legislature under section 120.541(3), F.S.

The Department requests that the Committee file its certificate with the Bureau of Administrative Code on November 17, 2020. The Department would like to file the proposed rule for final adoption with the Department of State on November 17, 2020, for an effective date of December 7, 2020.
