Dear Ms. Jackson:

The Department has reviewed your June 14, 2023, comments on the above-referenced proposed rules published in the Florida Administrative Register on May 30, 2023 and responds as follows.

Comment 12E-1.029(1)(a): Incorporated Material-Agreement for Financial Institution Data Matching, Form CS-EF134

P.2, II. A.: The statutory citation should be corrected to section 409.2579(1), F.S. Additionally, it appears that this agreement is requiring compliance with certain referenced federal regulations and statutes. If these are federal regulations and statutes to which compliance is already required of a financial institution, it appears that the language should reflect this (e.g., as required by state and federal laws...). If not, it appears that these materials might meet the definition of a rule as set forth in section 120.52(16), F.S., which would require incorporation by reference. Please review and advise.

Response: Form CS-EF134 has been revised to correct the statutory citation to section 409.2579(1), F.S. Some of the references have been removed and the language clarified.

P.2, II. C.: Please see the comment above regarding section II. A. of this form. Additionally, please advise whether the citations to 45 C.F.R. §§164.402 and .408, are relevant to financial institutions as these provisions appear to relate to HIPAA covered entities and protected health information.

Response: The citations to 45 C.F.R. §§164.402 and .408, are not relevant to financial institutions. Form CS-EF134 has been revised to remove these references.

Comment P.2, II. D.: Please see the comment above regarding section II. A. of this form. Additionally, please advise whether the citation to section 45 C.F.R. §307.13, is relevant to financial institutions as it appears to apply directly to state agencies.

Response: The citation to section 45 C.F.R. §307.13, is not relevant to financial institutions. Form CS-EF134 has been revised to remove the reference and delete unneeded language.

Comment 12E-1.029(1)(b): While chapter 12E-1, F.A.C., does contain direction as to where to obtain referenced incorporated forms, there does not appear to be direction for how an affected person may obtain a copy of this incorporated non-form material that is not solely via the Department of State, as is required by rule 1-1.013(2)(c), F.A.C.

Response: The Department will amend the rule text to note that members of the public may obtain copies of the Multistate Financial Institution Data Match Specifications Handbook, without cost, by writing to the Florida Department of Revenue, Mail Stop 2-4464, 5050 West Tennessee Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399.

Comment 12E-1.030(14)(b)1.: Incorporated Material-Proposed Order to Modify Administrative Support Order, CS-OA120R

Option 14.1: This option directs the input of either A1, A2, or A3, which does not appear to align with the options that follow (i.e., A., B., C.).

Option 14.2: This option directs the input of either B1 or B2, which does not appear to align with the options that follow (i.e., A., B., C.).

Response: Form CS-OA120R has been revised to correct the option references.

Comment 12E-1.030(15)(b): Incorporated Material-Notice of Intent to Terminate Support, Determine Arrears and Establish Payment on Arrears, CS-OA160

P.2, #4.: There is a blank check box at the end of the list of options in this section. Is this purposeful?

Response: Yes. This check box is used when free-form text is inserted as unanticipated or unique circumstances may require.

Comment 12E-1.030(15)(c): Incorporated Material-Final Order Terminating Support, Determining Arrears and Establishing Payment on Arrears, CS-OA178

P.2, #9.; This number consists of only a checkbox with no accompanying text. Is this purposeful?

Response: Yes. This check box is used when free-form text is inserted as unanticipated or unique circumstances may require.

Comment 12E-1.030(15)(f): Incorporated Material-Request to Terminate Support, CS-OA179

P.2, #5.: Please review whether this item can be revised for ease of understanding. As phrased, selecting, "No," results in a response using double negatives.

Response: Form CS-OA179 has been revised to correct the grammar and clarify #5.

Comment 12E-1.036(12): Incorporated Material-Proposed Order of Paternity, CS-OP30

P.2: This page includes a space for <<Option 45>> to be input, but there are no corresponding options for this included at the conclusion of the form.

Response: The text for Option 45 has been added to Form CS-OP30.

Comment 12E-1.036(13)(b)1.: Incorporated Material-Proposed Administrative Paternity and Support Order, CS-OA20

Option 14.1: This option directs the input of either A1, A2, or A3, which does not appear to align with the options that follow (i.e., A., B., C.).

Option 14.2: This option directs the input of either B1 or B2, which does not appear to align with the options that follow (i.e., A., B., C.).

Response: Form CS-OA020 has been revised to correct the option references.

Comment 12E-1.036(14)(d): Incorporated Material-Proposed Administrative Paternity and Support Order, CS-OX20

Option 14.1: This option directs the input of either A1, A2, or A3, which does not appear to align with the options that follow (i.e., A., B., C.).

Option 14.2: This option directs the input of either B1 or B2, which does not appear to align with the options that follow (i.e., A., B., C.).

Response: Form CS-OA020 has been revised to correct the option references.

Comment 12E-1.040(1)(c): Incorporated Material-Instructions for Completing the Declaration in Support of Establishing Parentage. CS-IS26i

P.1: At the top of this page, the commas should be removed that surround the word, "petitioner."

P.1, I.: In the final checkbox on this page, it appears that the word, "under," should be removed from the end of the first sentence.

Response: Form CS-IS26i has been revised as suggested.

Comment 12E-1.041(1)(c)2.: A reference should be included to set forth where the Family Law Affidavit (Short Form), CS-PO31, is incorporated by reference.

Response: The Department will amend the rule text to note that Form CS-PO31 is incorporated by reference in Rule 12E-1.036, F.A.C.

(b) The financial institution's electronic files containing data match records must be prepared according to the specifications prescribed by the Federal Office of Child Support Services Enforcement's Multistate Financial Institution Data Match Specifications Handbook, Version 3.0, December 30, 2020, (http://www.flrules.org/Gateway/reference.asp?No=Ref-xxxxx), incorporated herein by reference, effective xx/xx. Members of the public may obtain copies of the Multistate Financial Institution Data Match Specifications Handbook, without cost, by writing to the Florida Department of Revenue, Mail Stop 2-4464, 5050 West Tennessee Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399.

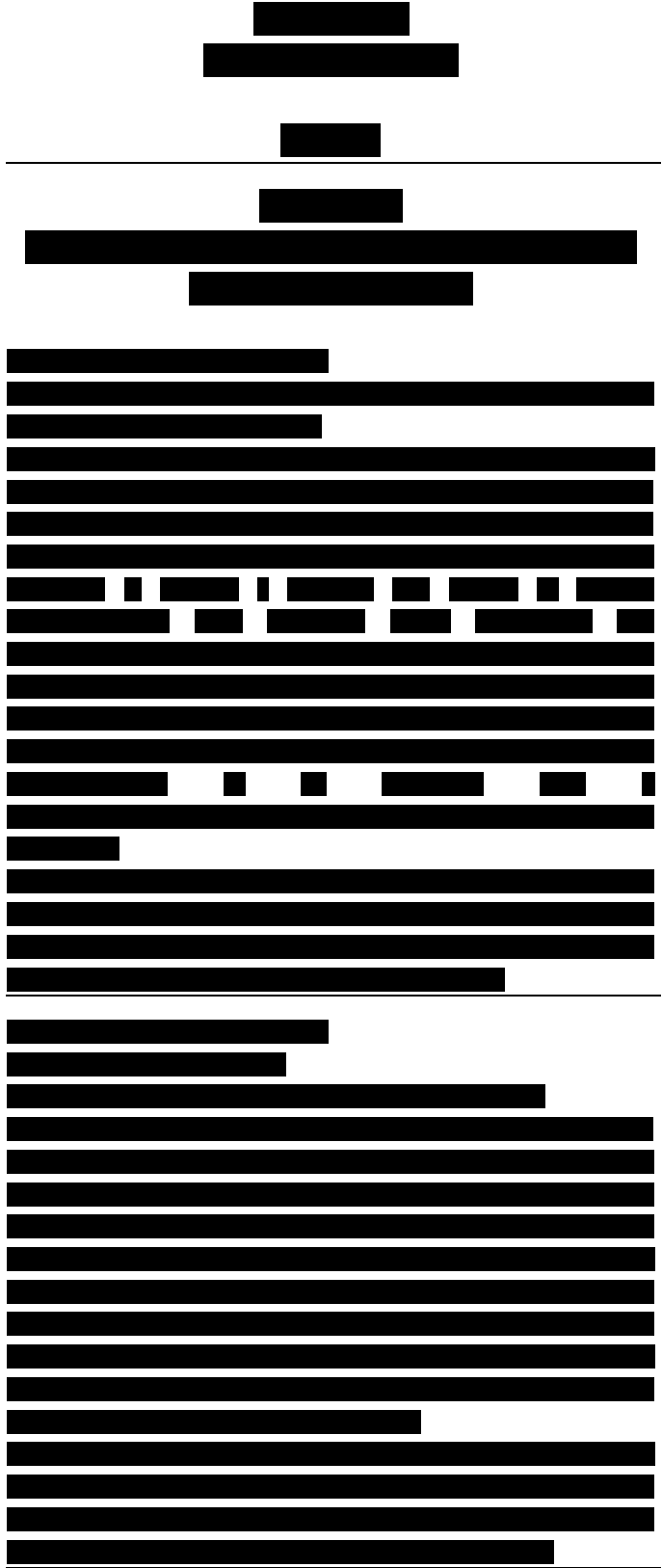
