1 Introduction

The Florida Department of Revenue (Department) provides import functionality for Insurance Premium Tax on the department's website. This functionality allows the submission of information to Department. The output file created using this specification will allow you to meet the insurance premium tax filing requirements for Schedule 12 and/or Schedule 13 of the DR-908 annual return. We encourage you to read the specifications thoroughly prior to creating your import file to help ensure accuracy and successful import of your data.

2 Terms and Conditions

By using the Department's online application to submit return data, the user acknowledges and agrees to the following terms and conditions:

- User is responsible for correctly employing the file import specifications to create an electronic return file.
- User is responsible for generating the output file being imported
- User agrees to make **no** configuration changes and/or modifications to the import file specifications. **Note:** Any configuration changes will result in the Department not being able to read the data submitted.
- User agrees that the import file specifications will be used for the sole purpose of converting specific tax information to meet the required format for importing data to the Department.

3 Import File Format Requirements

- No slashes or dashes are needed or allowed within date fields.
- All numeric amount fields are right-justified and must be preceded by zeroes. (Example: A field requires five digits; however, your entry is only a single digit. You would enter four zeroes followed by the entry, such as 00005 instead of just entering 5.)
- Fields that allow a sign are detailed in the file description.
- Field signs are trailing. (Example: 00009- = -9)
- Decimals are assumed for all currency fields. (Example: 10000 = \$100.00)
- Entries for jurisdictions and municipalities must be unique for each schedule type. No duplicates are allowed.
- The following special characters are not allowed: ~ ` ! # \$ % ^ & * () _ = [] { } | \ / ? , . > < ; : ' "

4 Import File Structure

- **Record Type 00 "Header Record" – Required record type.** Contains filing period and numeric file schedule key.
- **Record Type 12 "Schedule 12 Firefighters' Pension Trust Fund"** - This record type can be repeated for as many municipalities as the user is reporting in ascending numerical order.
- **Record Type 22 "Schedule 12 Firefighters' Trailer Record"** - Only one Firefighters' Trailer Record is allowed per import file.
- **Record Type 13 "Schedule 13 Police Officers' Retirement Trust Fund"** - This record type can be repeated for as many municipalities as the user is reporting in ascending numerical order.
- **Record Type 23 "Schedule 13 Police Officers' Trailer Record"** - Only one Police Officers' Trailer Record is allowed per file.
- **Record Type 99 "Trailer Record" – Required record type.** Total count of all municipalities included in import file.

5 Field Descriptions and Restrictions

Each import file consists of fixed-length text. In the following tables, the position number is the place that the character must occupy within the line in the file. There are two possible character types:

- N = numerical characters only
- X = alphanumeric and special characters. In this import specification, it is used to refer to positive (+) or negative (-) signs associated with numerical amounts.

7 Importing the File

- Go to the Department's [File and Pay](#) webpage, then select "Insurance Premium Tax."
- Select from two login options:
 - Enter your UserID and Password: A registered taxpayer, who enrolls to file and pay electronically, receives a user ID and password for logging in to online applications.
 - Enter your Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN) and Business Partner (BP) Numbers: If you are a registered taxpayer, but not enrolled to file and pay electronically, you can log in with your FEI and BP Numbers.
- An enrolled user has access to additional functions, such as view your filing history and reprint returns. To enroll to file and pay electronically, access the Department's [e-Services Enrollment](#) application. Once logged in, review the Bulletin Board for important changes to laws or processes that may affect return filing. Click the "Next" button when finished.
- To test your file, click "Check Import File Format" button. Submitting a test file **does not** cause a submission and **does not** file a return.
- Once you have tested your file and are ready to import it, click on the "Import a File" button.
