SSNs obtained for tax administration purposes are confidential under Sections 213.053 and 119.071, Florida Statutes, and are not subject to disclosure as public records. Collection of your SSN is authorized under state and federal law. Read our [Privacy Statement](#) for more information regarding the state and federal law governing the collection, use, or release of SSNs, including authorized exceptions. Note: Out-of-country applicants will not have an SSN and may use their Visa Number or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN). Officers of corporations, LLCs, estates, trusts, and governmental agencies will be required to provide the last four digits of their SSN.
