



Tax-Exempt Admissions Expanded

Effective July 1, 2022, admissions to certain FIFA World Cup matches, Formula One Grand Prix races and Daytona 500 races are exempt from sales tax.

FIFA World Cup Matches

Admissions to any FIFA World Cup match sanctioned by the Fédération Internationale de Football Association (FIFA), including any World Cup qualifying match held up to 12 months before the FIFA World Cup matches, are exempt from sales tax.

Formula One Grand Prix Races

Admissions to any Formula One Grand Prix race sanctioned by the Fédération Internationale de l'Automobile, including any qualifying or support races held at the circuit up to 72 hours before the Grand Prix race, are exempt from sales tax.

Daytona 500 Races

Admissions to any Daytona 500 race sanctioned by the National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR), including any qualifying or support races held at the same track up to 72 hours before the race, are exempt from sales tax.
