Beginning 12:01 a.m. on January 2, 2024, Florida taxpayers may apply for an allocation of credit for state fiscal year 2024-25 for the following multi-tax credits:

Tax Credit

- Live Local Program •
- New Worlds Reading Initiative
- Strong Families •
- Florida Tax Credit Scholarship Program (tax credits for contributions to nonprofit scholarship-funding organizations)
