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Florida Partnership Information Return (Form F-1065) Electronic Filing Available

For tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2022, the *Florida Partnership Information Return* (Form F-1065) may be filed electronically. Electronic filing of Form F-1065 is available through the Internal Revenue Service's Modernized e-File (MeF) federal/state program using approved software.

Every partnership doing business, earning income, or existing in Florida that has a partner subject to the Florida Corporate Income/Franchise Tax must file Florida Form F-1065. A limited liability company is considered a partnership if classified as a partnership for federal income tax purposes.

Filing your information return electronically ensures quick, efficient, and accurate processing.
