- Rental or purchase of a "seeing-eye" guide dog.
Purchase of food and other items for a guide dog.

To be eligible for a consumer's certificate of exemption, a blind person must first hold an identification card issued by the Florida Department of Education, Bureau of Blind Services, certifying the holder as visually impaired. Any blind person holding an identification card issued by the Department of Education, Bureau of Blind Services will be issued a Certificate of Exemption for the Blind (Form DR-152). The exemption certificate does not expire.
