#### I. Participating in Public Meetings Using the Internet

To participate in a Florida Department of Revenue public meeting using the internet, there are two options:

- Register with WebEx, a web and phone sharing program. Internet access and a directline telephone (area code+ 7 digit phone number with no extension) are required. Benefits include:
  - Seeing and hearing meeting participants in real-time. WebEx service is free; there is no cost to participate via WebEx.
  - Viewing documents presented during the meeting on your computer in real-time.
- 2. By teleconference.
  - You will not be able to view documents in real time.
  - Documents will be available on the website prior to the public meeting and also for downloading during the meeting.
  - You can submit public comments by sending an email to a designated email account and having it read into the meeting's record by a Revenue staff member.



#### Directions

The Capital Circle Office Center (CCOC) is located southeast of Tallahassee on State Highway 319 (Capital Circle Southeast). State Highway 319 divides the CCOC into an east and west campus. The Department of Revenue is located on the west campus.

#### From Apalachee Parkway

Turn south on State Highway 319 (Capital Circle) and drive 3 miles before turning right on Shumard Oak Boulevard.

#### From Interstate 10

Exit the Interstate at the Thomasville Road intersection and drive south on State Highway 319 (Capital Circle). In 8.5 miles turn right at Shumard Oak Boulevard.

#### From Highway 90 East

Turn south onto Capital Circle and travel 3 miles south of the Apalachee Parkway. Turn right at Shumard Oak Boulevard.

#### From the Airport

Drive east on Capital Circle for 7.7 mile. Turn left at Shumard Oak Boulevard.
