Fuel Tax Rates Adjusted September 1, 2023, Through December 31, 2023

Beginning September 1, 2023, Miami-Dade County's local option tax will decrease from 6 cents per gallon to zero cents per gallon. As a result, the statewide tax rate on motor fuel and the collection allowance will decrease.

Motor Fuel

The minimum statewide motor fuel tax rate will decrease from 35.225 cents per gallon to **26.325 cents per gallon**. Miami-Dade County's motor fuel tax rate will decrease from 39.225 cents per gallon to **30.325 cents per gallon**. The ninth-cent and local option rates vary by county. For a list of local option and ninth-cent rates by county, review the Motor Fuel Tax Rates chart available on the Florida Department of Revenue's website at floridarevenue.com/taxes/rates. Miami-Dade County's State Comprehensive Enhanced Transportation System (SCETS) rate will decrease from 8.9 cents per gallon to **6.0 cents per gallon**. The inspection fee on motor fuel will remain **0.125 cents per gallon**.

Minimum Local Option Tax on Motor Fuel Collected at Fuel Terminals

Terminal Suppliers – In addition to the 20.2 cents per gallon of state fuel taxes collected at the loading rack, terminal suppliers must collect a **minimum local option fuel tax of 6.0 cents per gallon, a pollutants tax of 2.071 cents per gallon, and an inspection fee of 0.125 cents per gallon** on each gallon of motor fuel sold to licensed wholesalers. Total fuel taxes collected by terminal suppliers on sales of motor fuel to licensed wholesalers is 28.396 cents per gallon beginning September 1, 2023.

Terminal Suppliers/Wholesalers – Terminal suppliers/wholesalers must remit to the Department the local option tax rate above the minimum on motor fuel sold to retail dealers or end users that do not have a wholesaler or terminal supplier license. This rate is in addition to the minimum local option tax of 6.0 cents per gallon collected by terminal suppliers when fuel is removed from a licensed terminal.

Wholesaler Inventory Management

Due to the reduction in the statewide gasoline rate, wholesalers that purchase fuel in August 2023 and carry that inventory over into September 2023 will pay an additional \$0.089 per gallon. Likewise, a wholesaler's inventory that is purchased in December 2023 and carried over into January 2024 will receive an additional \$0.089 per gallon when the fuel is sold. Wholesalers should manage their inventories to avoid carrying more fuel into September (the beginning of the reduction period) than into January (the anticipated end of the reduction period). Wholesalers should try to have the same number of gallons on-hand at the end of December that they had at the end of August.

Filing Your Return

Taxpayers obligated to file electronically must use the appropriate method as specified in Rule Chapters 12B-5 and 12-24, Florida Administrative Code. There is a \$5,000 penalty if you do not file electronically when obligated to do so.

Returns are due on the 1st and late after the 20th day of the month following the collection period. If the 20th is a Saturday, Sunday, or state or federal holiday, returns are timely if filed electronically, postmarked, or delivered in person on the first business day following the 20th day of the month. When you electronically pay or you electronically file and pay at the same time, you must initiate your electronic payment and receive a confirmation number no later than 5 p.m. ET on the business day prior to the 20th to avoid penalty and interest. Failure to properly file a tax return may result in the assessment of penalty and interest and loss of the collection allowance.
