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Gilchrist County Increases Its Tourist Development Tax Rate Beginning February 1, 2020

Effective February 1, 2020, the tourist development tax rate on transient rental transactions occurring within Gilchrist County increases from 2% to 3%. The combined tax rate for Gilchrist County transient rentals will be 10%, composed of the 6% state sales tax, the 3% tourist development tax, and the 1% small county surtax. The Gilchrist County Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance No. 2019-06 increasing the tourist development tax.

The combined tax for transient rentals in Gilchrist County is 10%. The combined rate is composed of 6% sales tax plus the 1% small county surtax, and the 3% Gilchrist County tourist development tax..
